8. Finally Vote of thanks proposed by Ms. Vidya Mulmule.



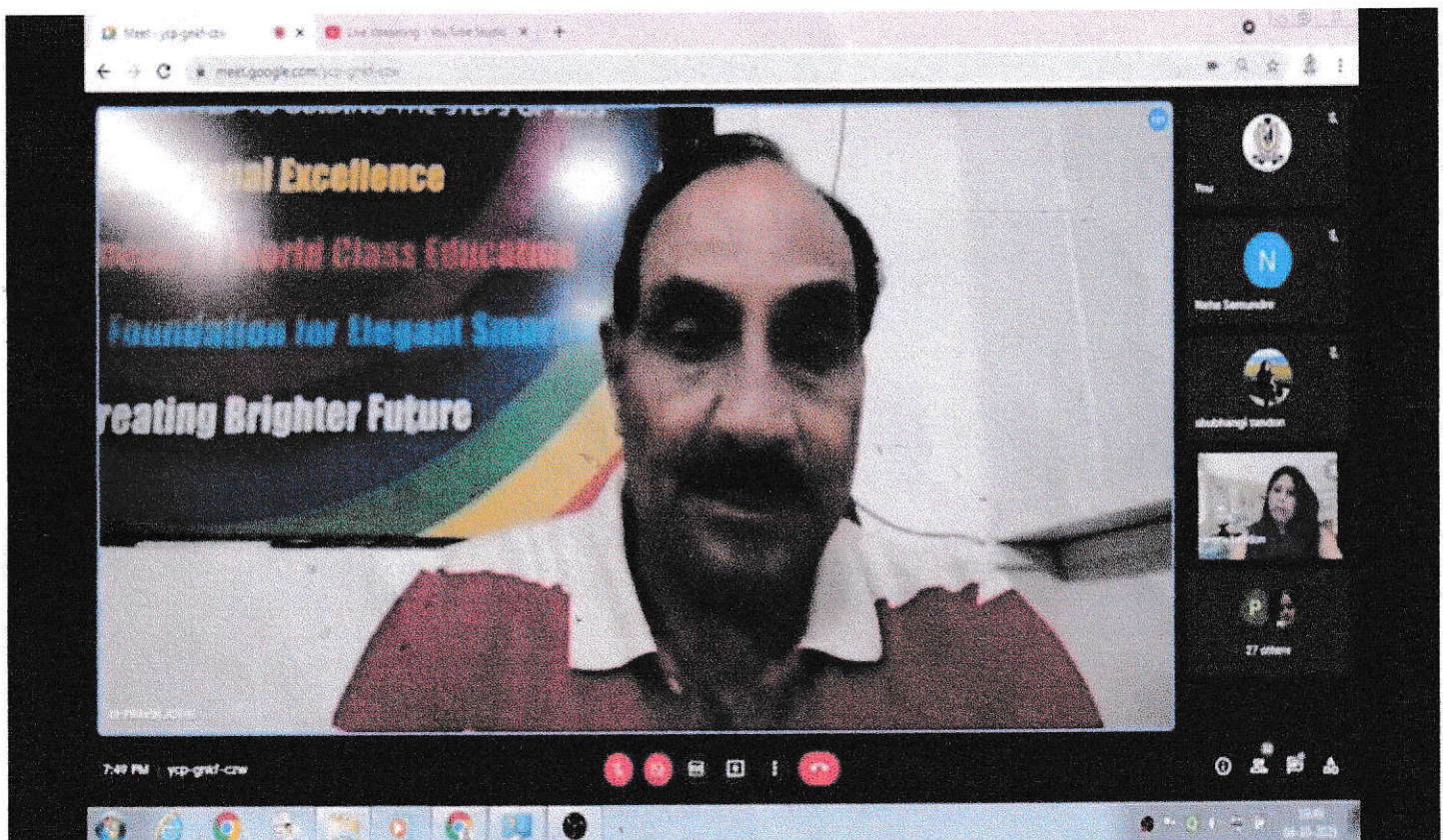
**Outcome: -**

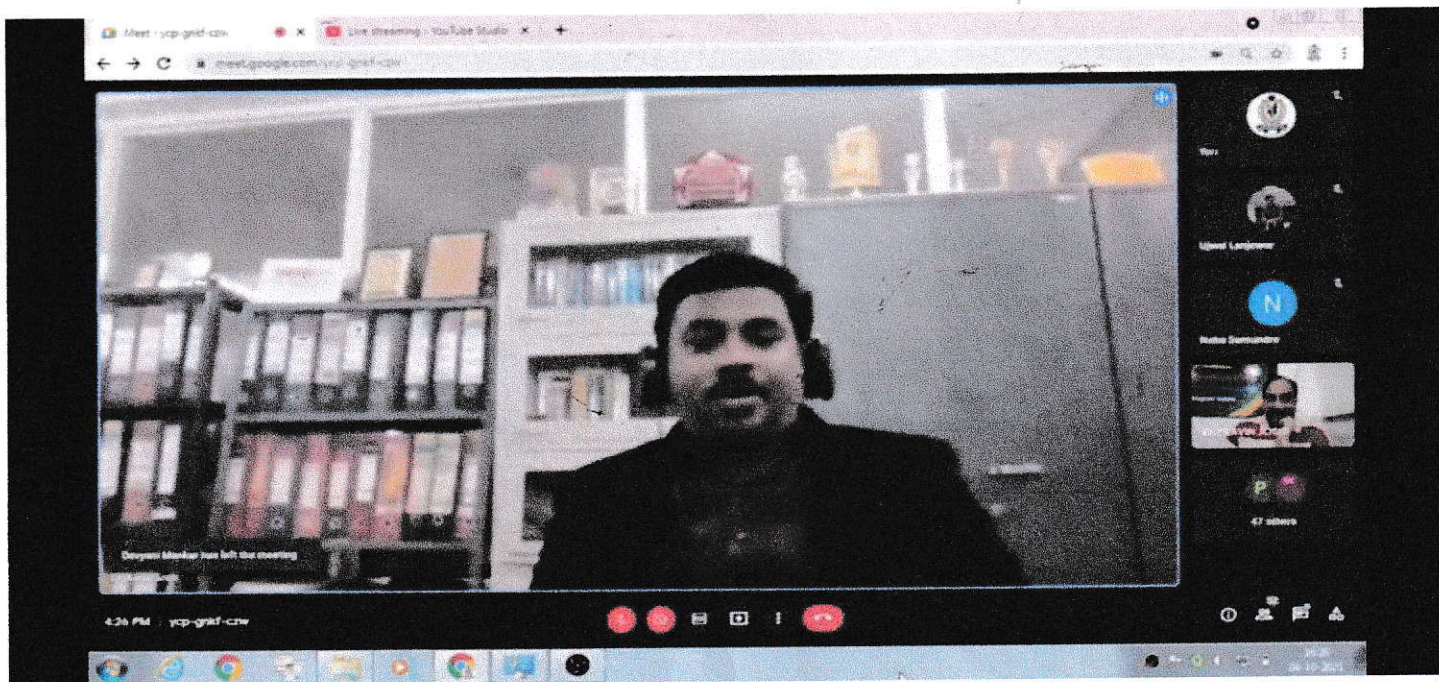

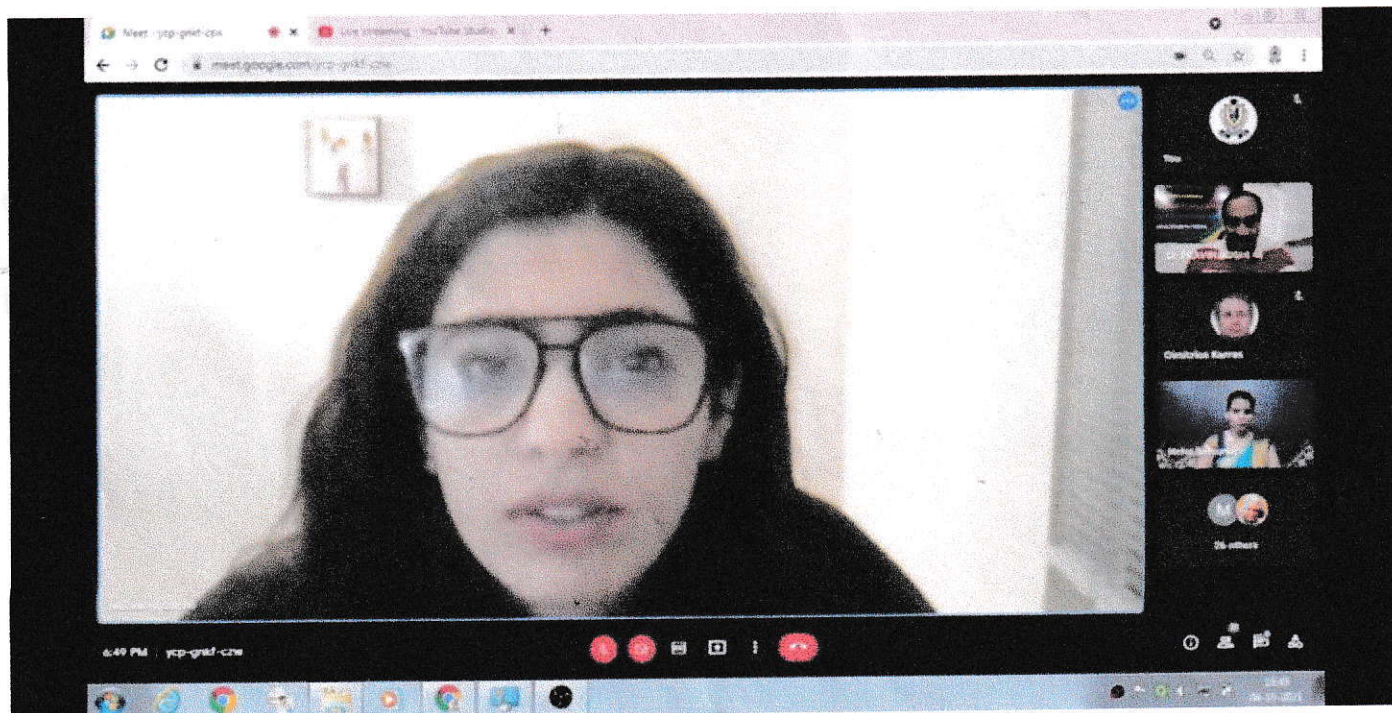

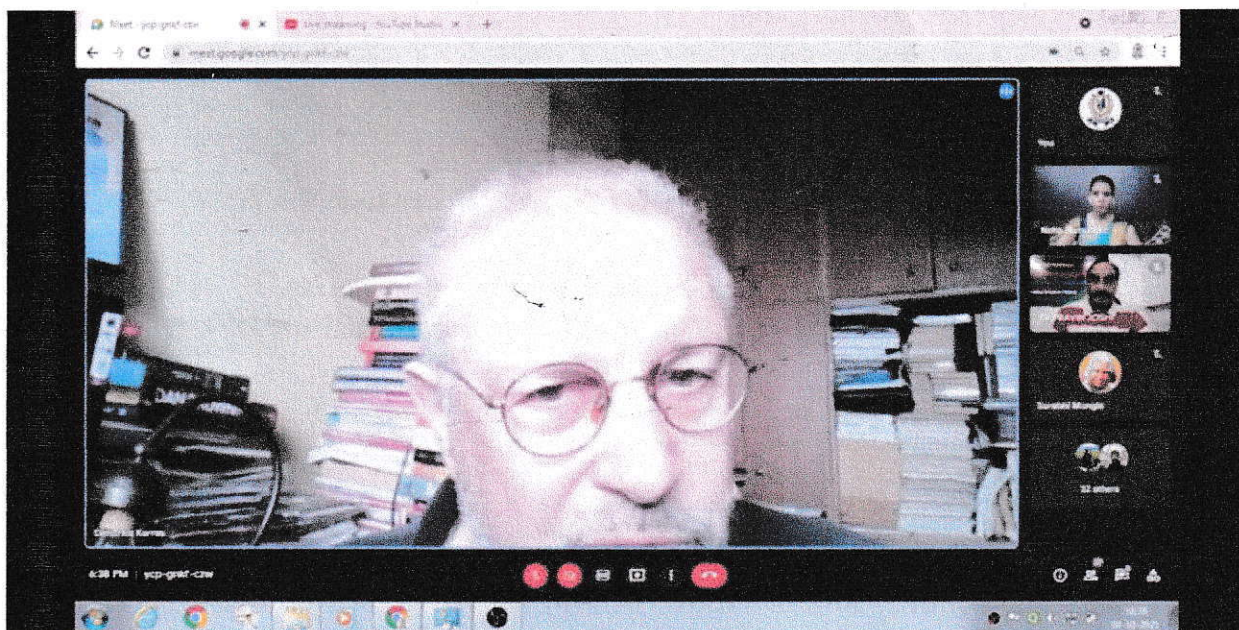
