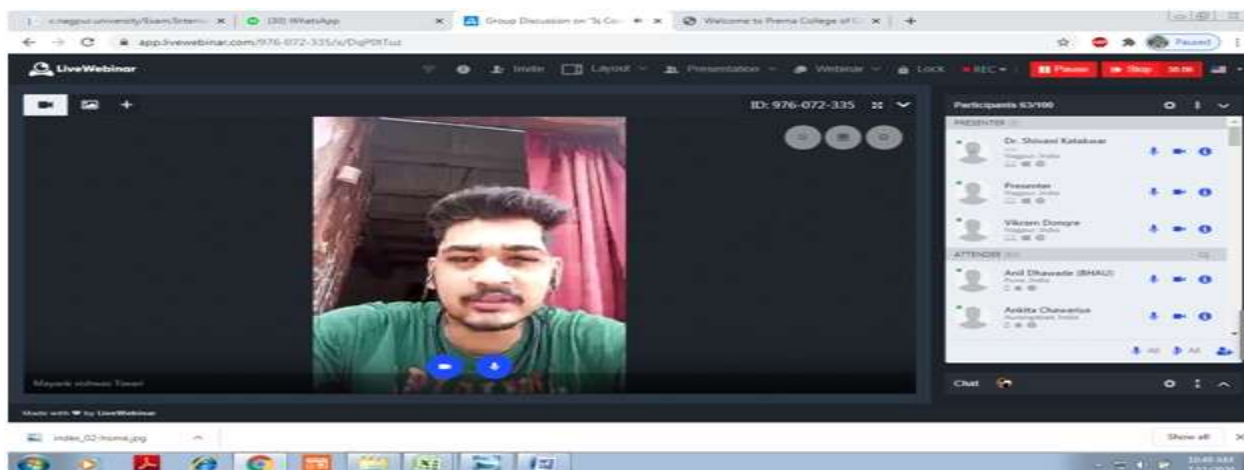

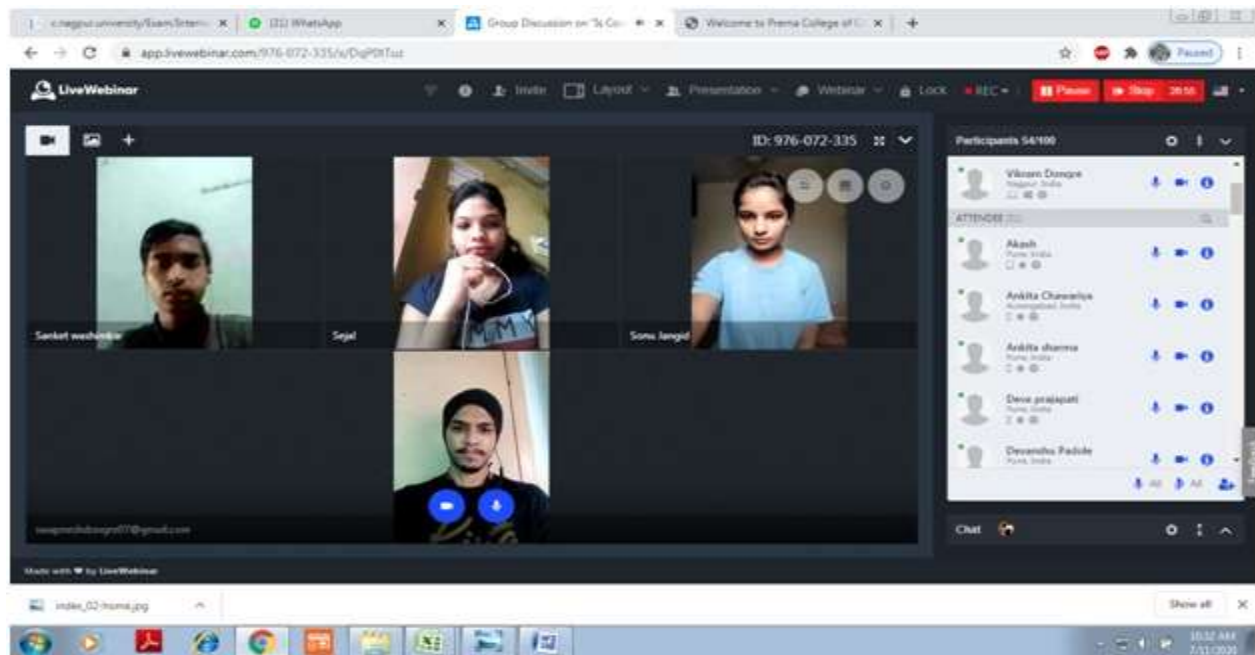
In COVID-19 situation such program will provide platform to students to express their views and skills in public. The session benefited the students a lot.

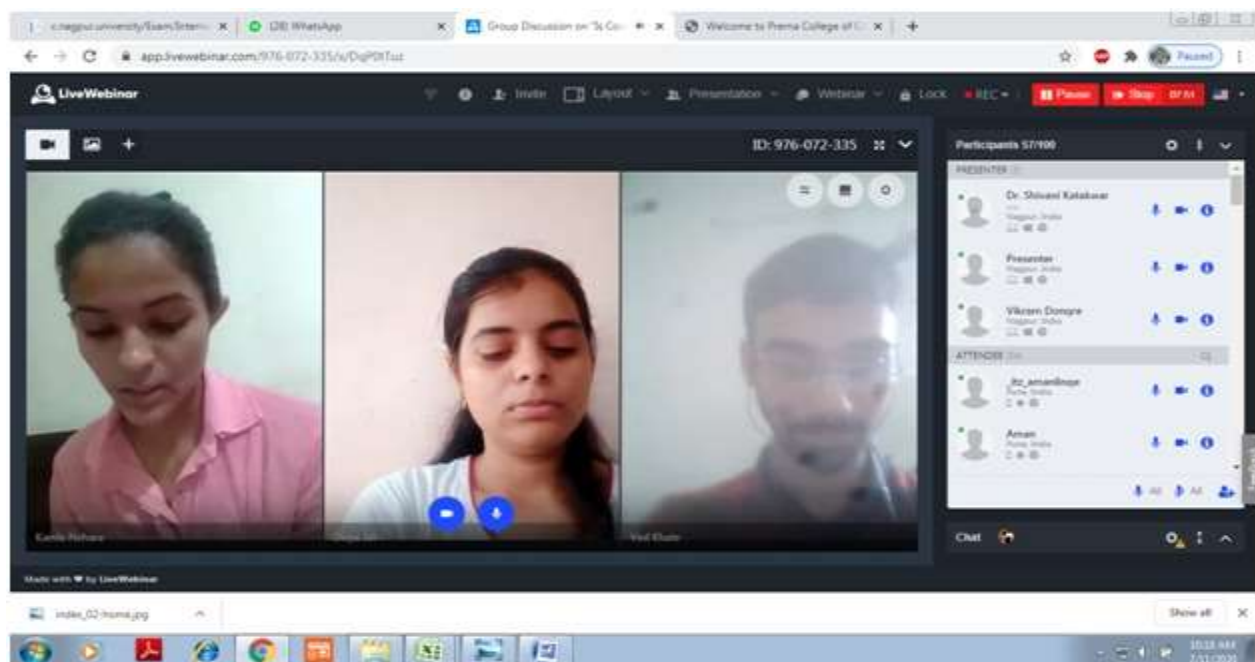
