Highlights: -

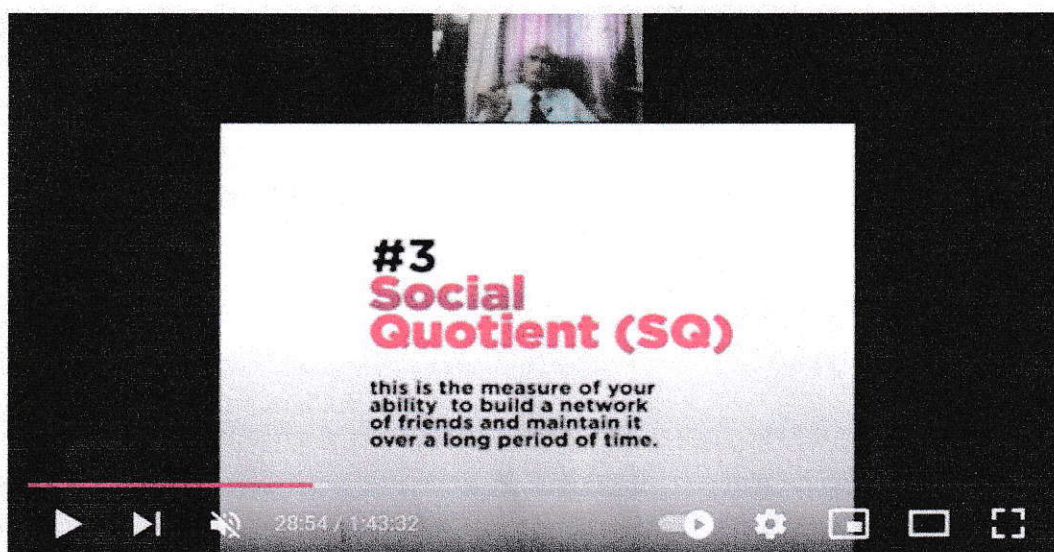
