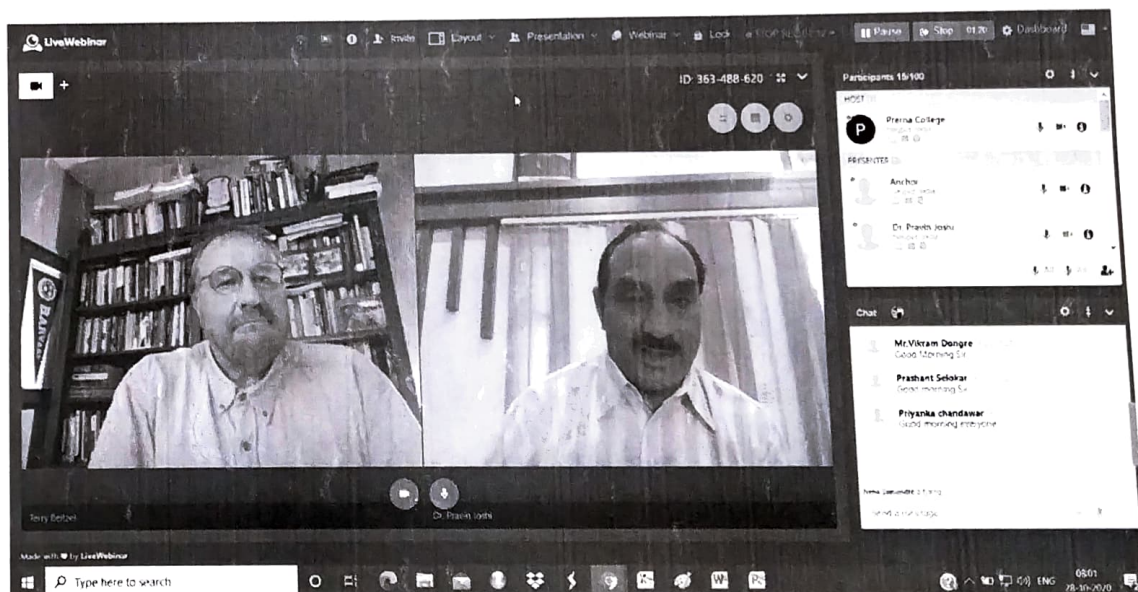


Report on Virtual Talk by Prof. Terry Beitzel (2020 – 2021)
