

Highlights Day:- 5 (05th July,2021)


1. Ms. Reena Urkande welcomed and introduced the resource person Dr Pushpendra Kumar to the virtual gathering.

Valedictory Function.


1. On the Tenth day, the faculty improvement programme was concluded with the valedictory function.

Outcomes: -


1. The faculty members gained information about various research and research methodologies.







Chief Guest Prof. Arun DN Bajpai addressing the participants.



Chair Person Dr S. C. Gulhane addressing the participants.


