5. At the end of the program, Mrs Afsha Khan proposed vote of thanks.

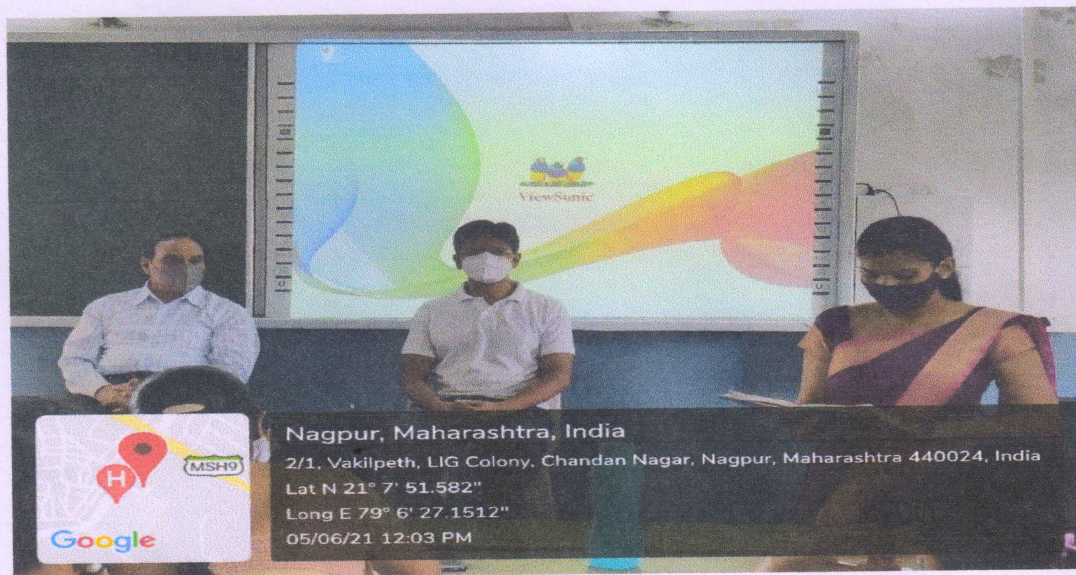
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Outcomes: -


1. The faculty members gained knowledge about a new dimensional variable-Advance Technology.

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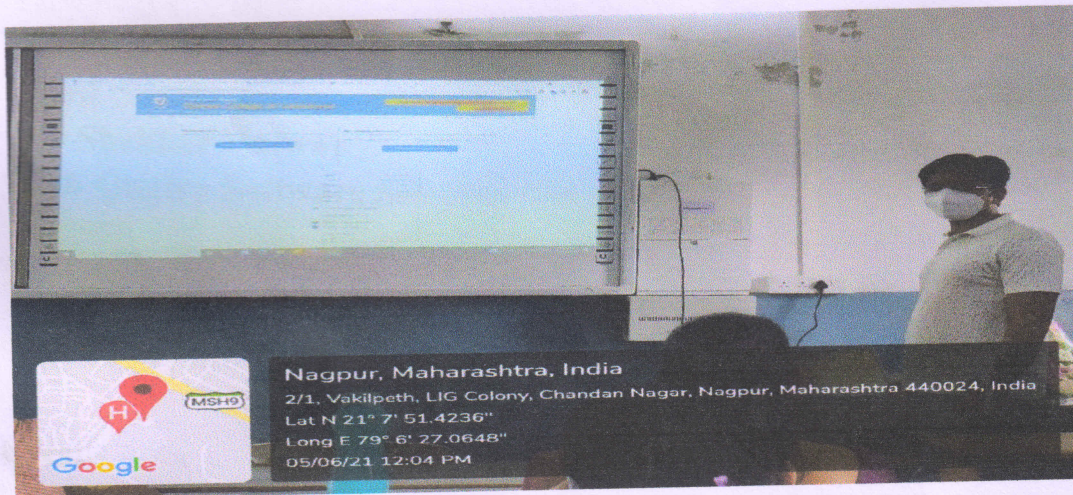
