Outcome: -

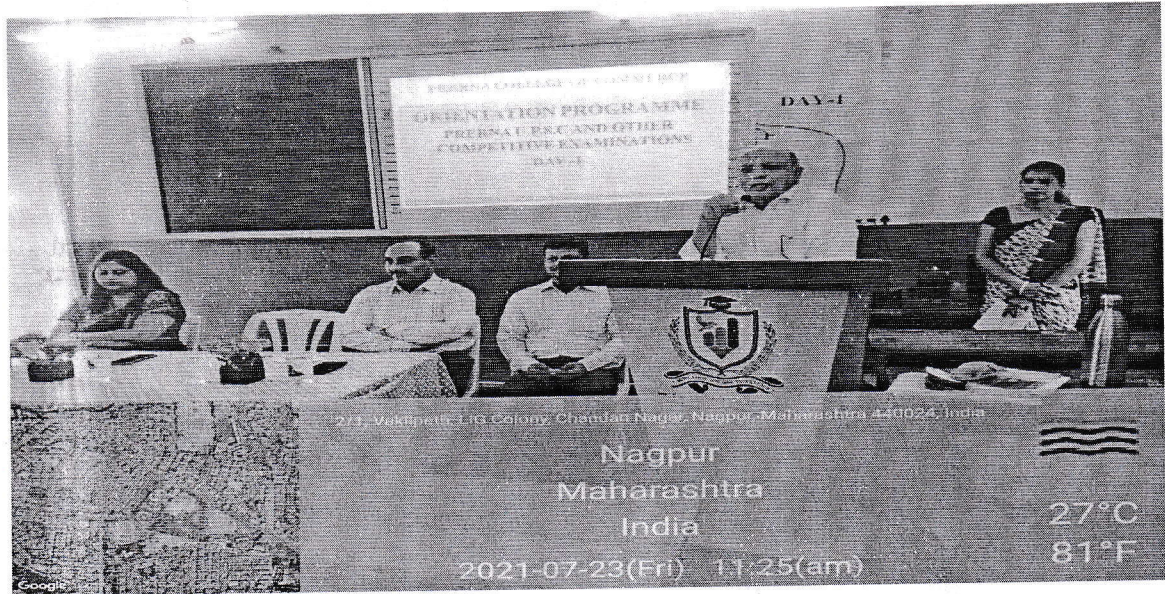
1. The students gained information about various competitive examinations.
