Objectives:

1. To bring awareness amongst the village population of the country who have no access to basic healthcare services or knowledge about the diseases they are suffering from.
2. To serve the society by providing basic healthcare facilities and knowledge regarding health issues in rural areas as well as to promote social development of society.
3. To provide free and high quality medical services to poor and needy people from the village adopted by Prerna College of Commerce.
4. To provide welfare measures to staff members and students of Prerna College of Commerce.
5. To raise health awareness among the people of Adyali, Vihirgaon, Kalmna and Umargaon Takali.
6. To diagnose illness in basic check-ups and provide proper guidance for further treatment.
7. To advise people to follow up with their local doctors or Public Health Centres.

Highlights:

1. The camp was inaugurated by the hands of Dr. S. C. Gulhane, Secretary of Prerna Sewa Mandal in the presence of CEO Abhilasha Gudadhe, Dr Pravin Joshi, director, Prerna college, Dr. Ujjwal Lanjewar principal, Prerna college.
2. Dr Pravin Joshi welcomed the camp coordinator, Dr. Anuprita Madage from Lata Mangeshkar Hospital and Medical social worker, Mr. Ramesh Ramtekkar.
3. Dr. Pravin Joshi also welcomed Mrs. Savita Borkar, Head of Panchayat and Mr. Narayan Kapse, Co-head of Panchayat of Adyali village.
4. The team of doctors and other staff members from Lata Mangeshkar Hospital were welcomed by faculty members and volunteers of Prerna College of Commerce.
5. More than eight Out Patient Department (OPD) such as General medicine, ENT, Gynaecologist, Orthopaedist, Dermatologists, Paediatricians, Ophthalmologists, Dental experts, surgical specialist etc. were treated the patients.



6. People from aforementioned four villages were freely benefited and get satisfactory diagnosis from specialists in this camp.
7. In this camp team of 40 Doctors and other medical staff from Lata Mangeshkar Hospital diagnosed 200 people and free medication is provided to them.
8. The patients who required further treatments were provided with green cards of Lata Mangeshkar Hospital.
9. Dr. Anuprita Madage announced 50% discounts on every treatment and free food to patients. She also announced free surgery and hernia treatment on an account of 75th anniversary (Amrit Mahotsav) of Lata Mangeshkar Hospital.
10. It was a day long activity in which refreshment as well as time to time beverages were offered to team of doctors and their volunteers by Prerna college of commerce.

Impacts:

1. The people from four villages were benefited by this free health checkup camp.
2. The people became aware about regular health checkup for healthy life.
3. Faculty members and students of Prerna College also get benefited from this camp.
4. The patients who need further assistance of doctors were provided with green cards.
5. This camp made people getting the healthcare at the right time, and seeing the doctor early enough before a small health problem turns serious.
6. People got information about upcoming schemes of Lata Mangeshkar Hospital on an account of 75th anniversary (Amrit Mahotsav).

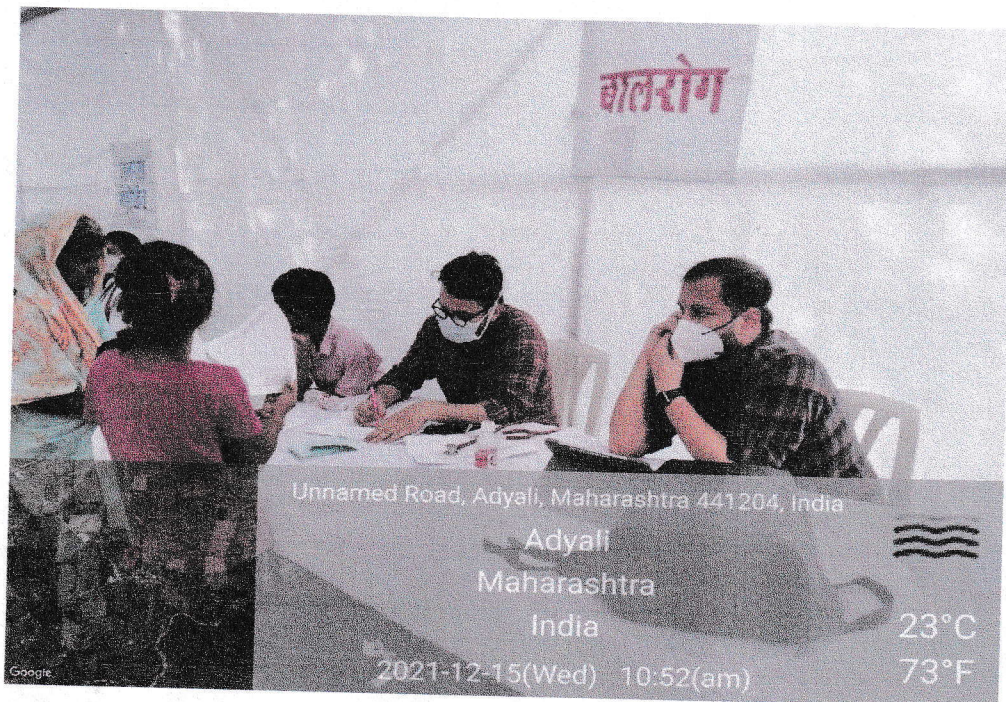

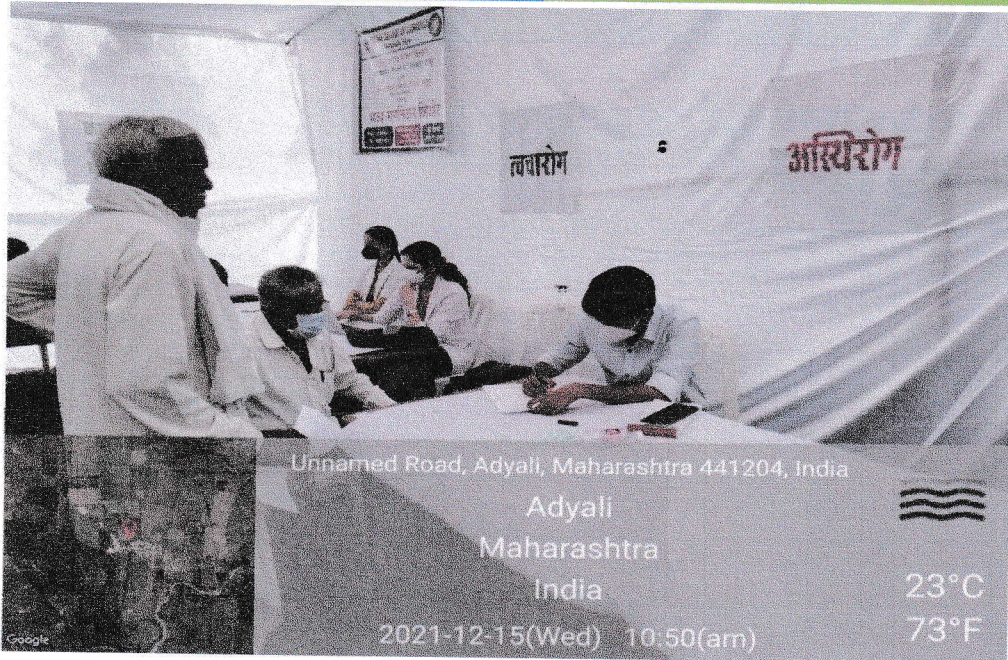
