Objectives:

1. To literate the little literate in writing skills.
2. To improve their reading skills.
3. To teach them how to construct simple and compound sentences.
4. To teach them how to pronounce complex words and sentences.
5. To enhance their proficiency level in reading and writing.
6. To take them two steps ahead of the basic literacy stage.

Highlights:

1. The advance literacy training program was conducted in memory of Savitribai Phule from 5th January 2022 to 15th January 2022 from 11:30am to 12:30 pm.
2. The program was conducted for the period of ten days. On different days different teachers from the college taught the participants as per the planned syllabus.
3. At the same time the participants were motivated by the teachers to keep on practicing reading and writing at home also. They were advised to read the books of first to fourth standard.

4. During the ten days program the participants were taught the advance stage of literacy.
5. They were also taught how to construct compound words and complex words. At the same time the focus was on developing their reading skills.
6. The participants were asked to read aloud and their pronunciations were corrected. They were also taught how to write in readable handwriting and effort was also made to improve their handwriting.
7. On the last day a test was also conducted in which the participants did well.

Outcomes:

1. The learners were well acquainted with the form and structure of the compound and complex words.
2. They developed their reading skills.
3. They developed their writing skills
4. Their confidence level increased.
5. Some simple sentences they were able to write on their own.
6. Overall the program succeeded in taking them ahead of the basic literacy.

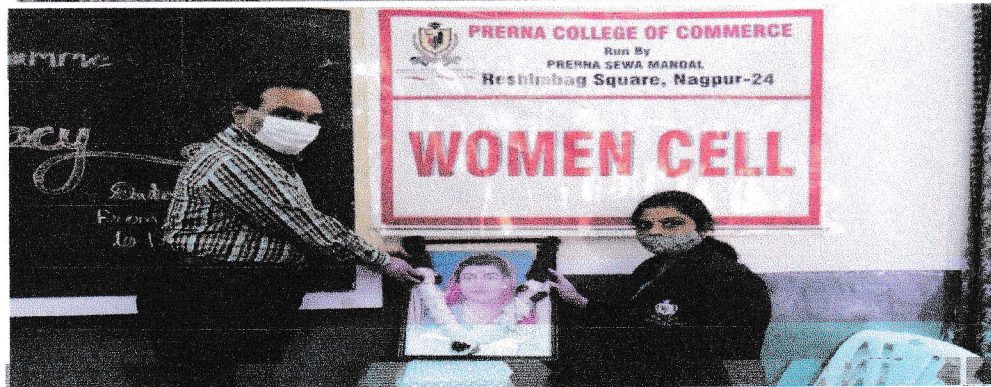
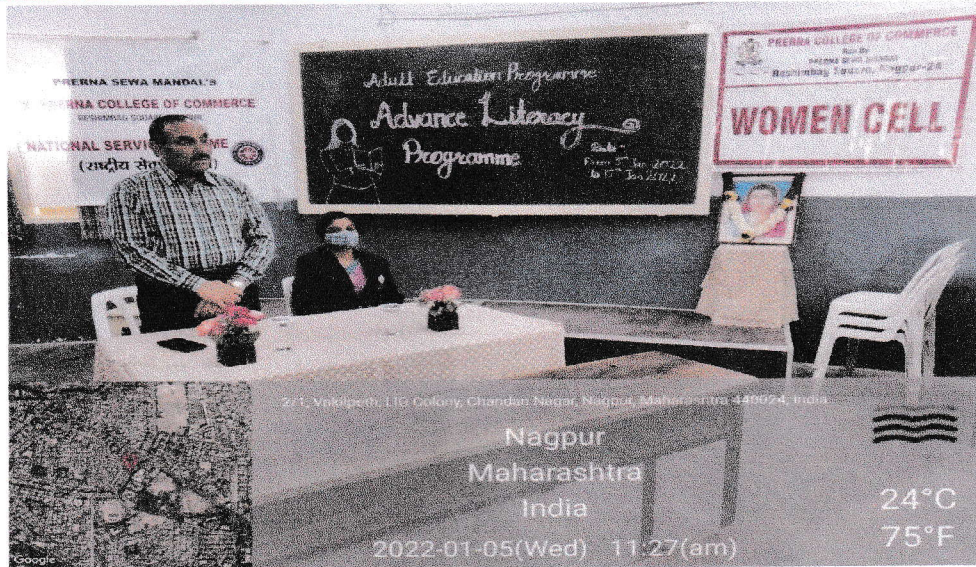

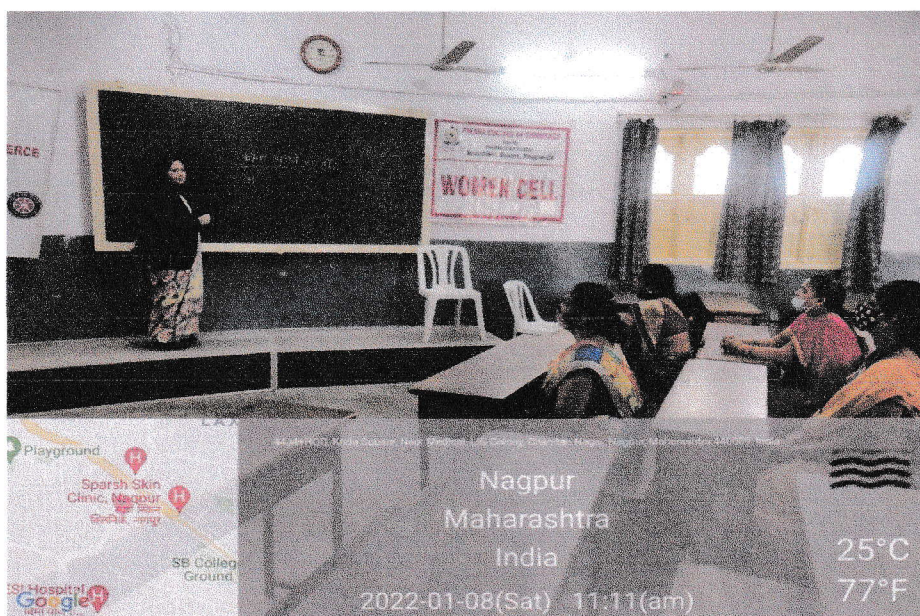

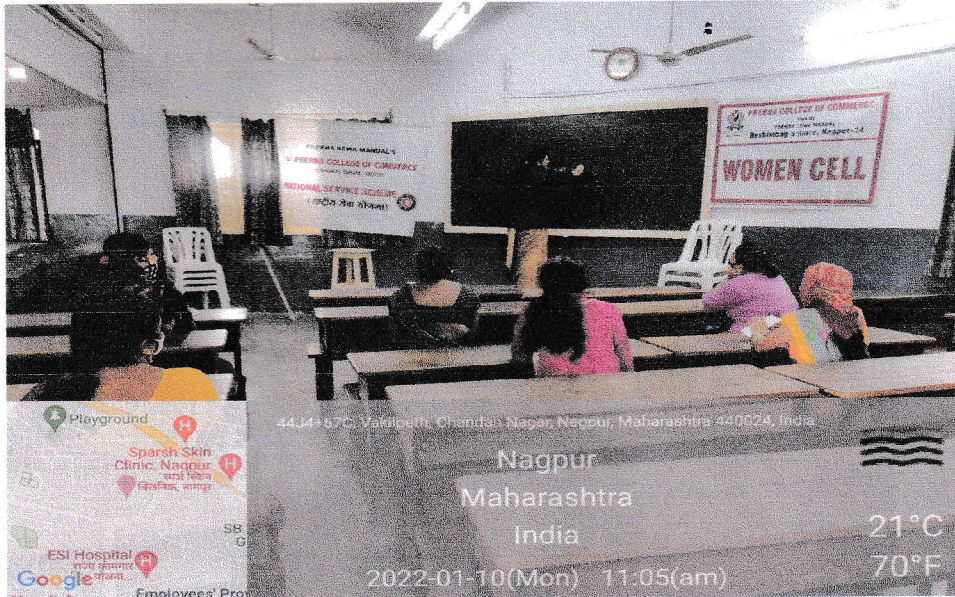

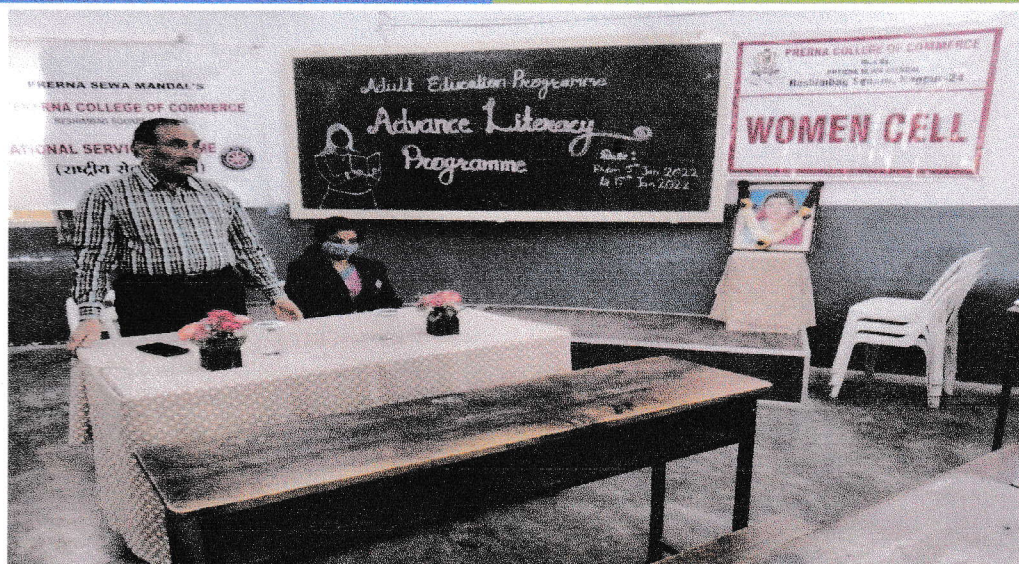
