6. The main focus was on changing society's attitude towards girls.

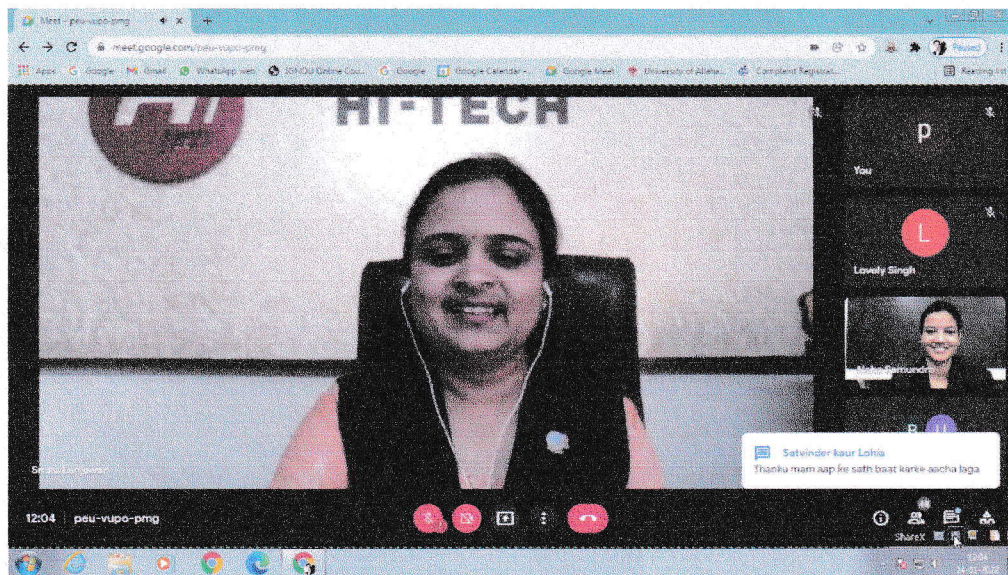

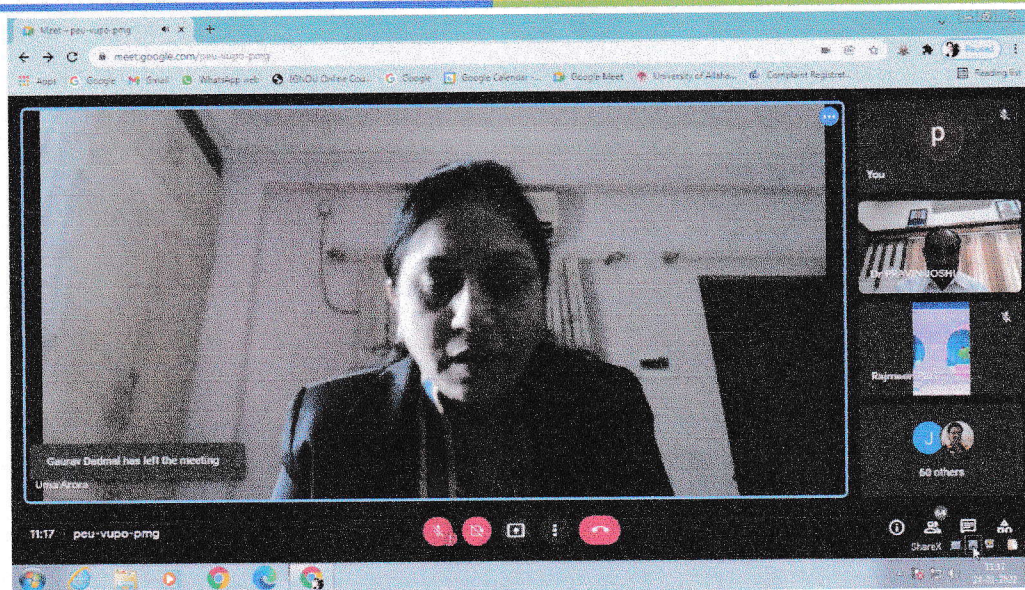

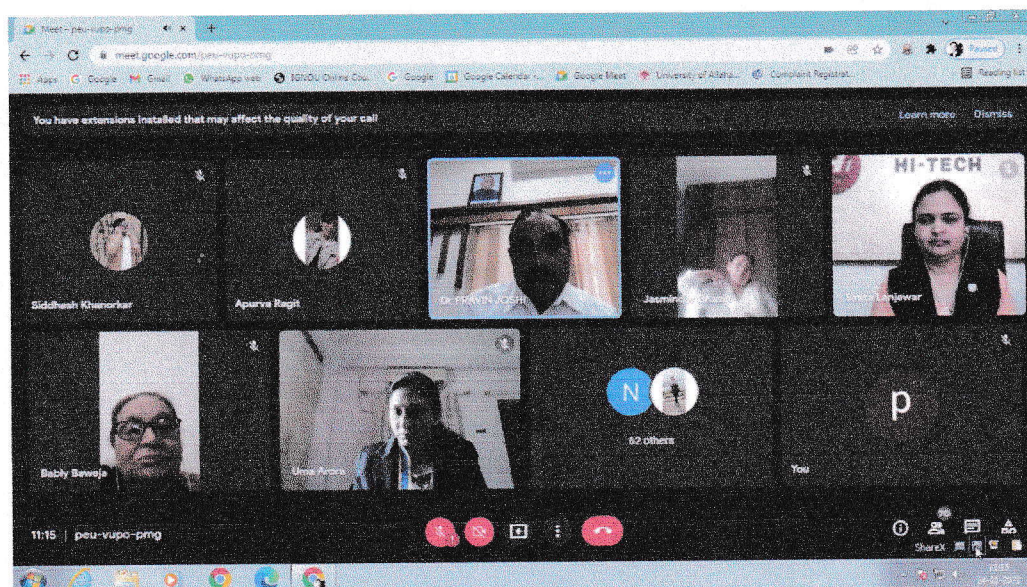
