Second Session

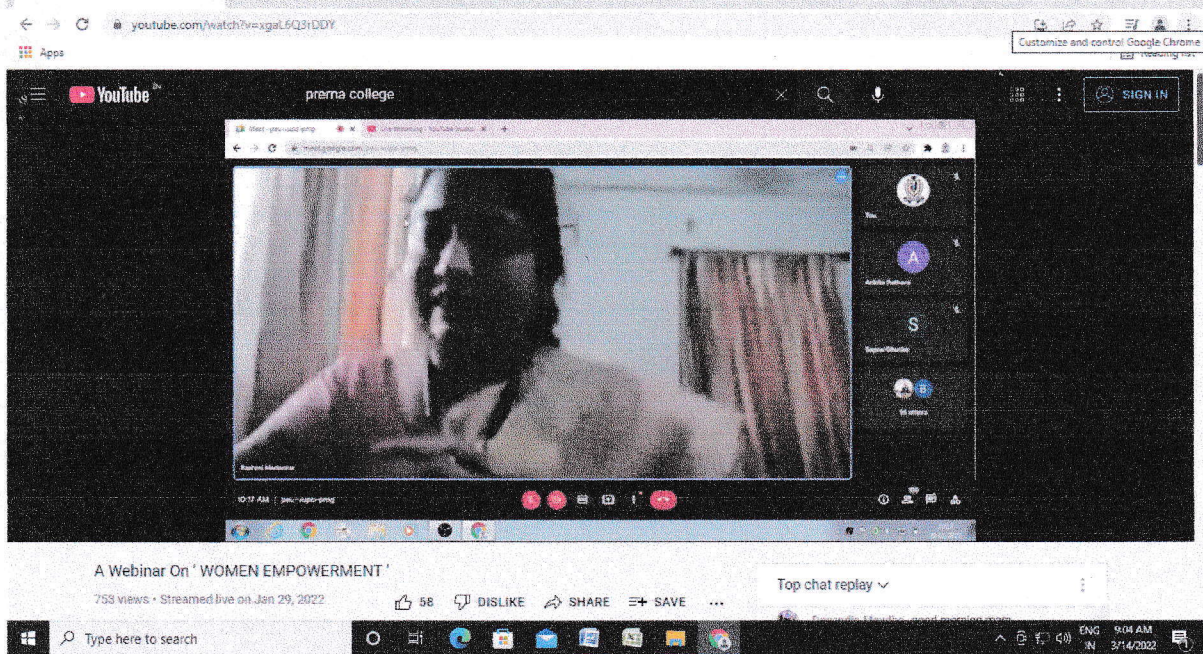
1. Mrs. Ankita Pathrabe welcomed, Dr.Muthmainnah speaker of the second session.

Outcome: -

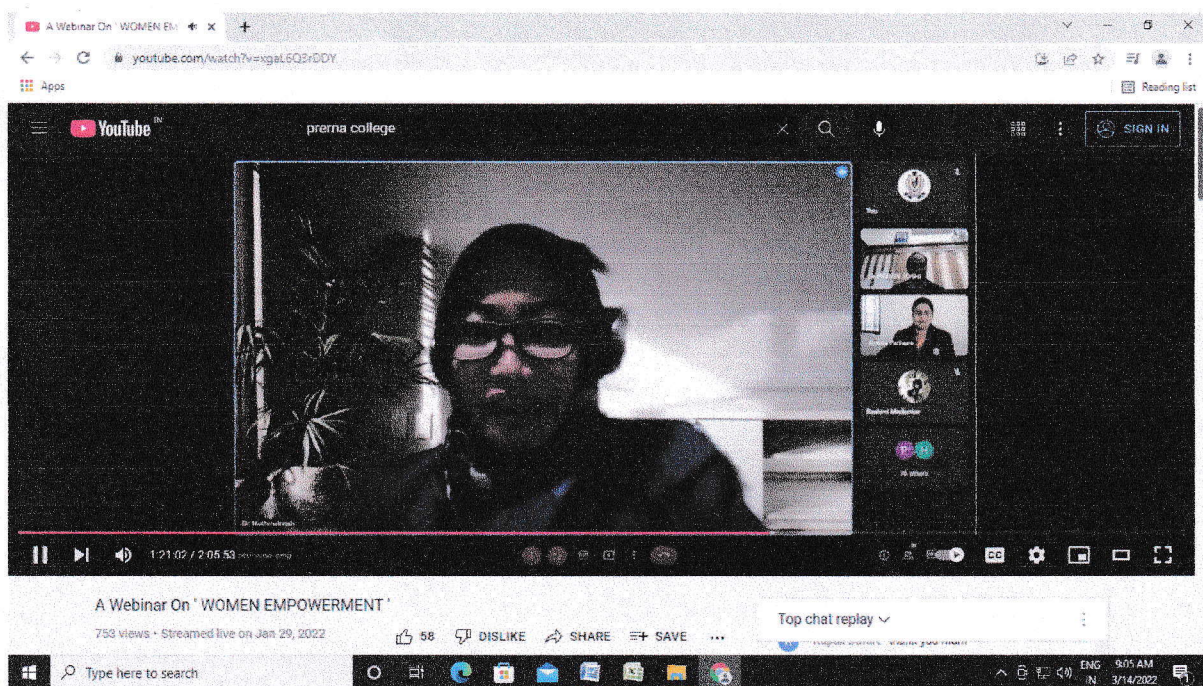
1. The students learnt the importance of education in life of women.
