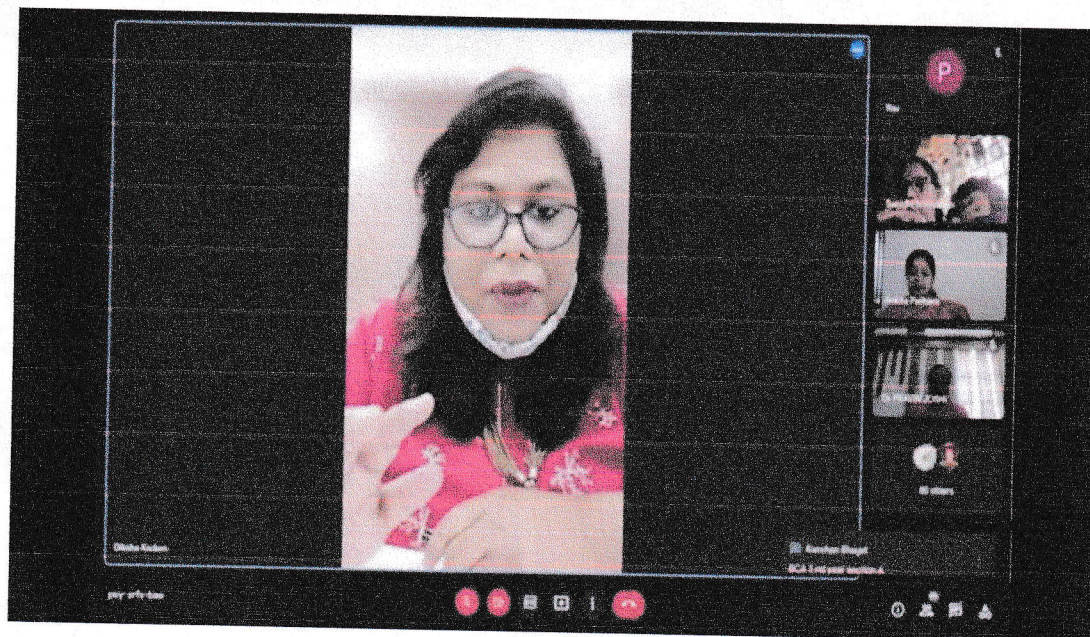
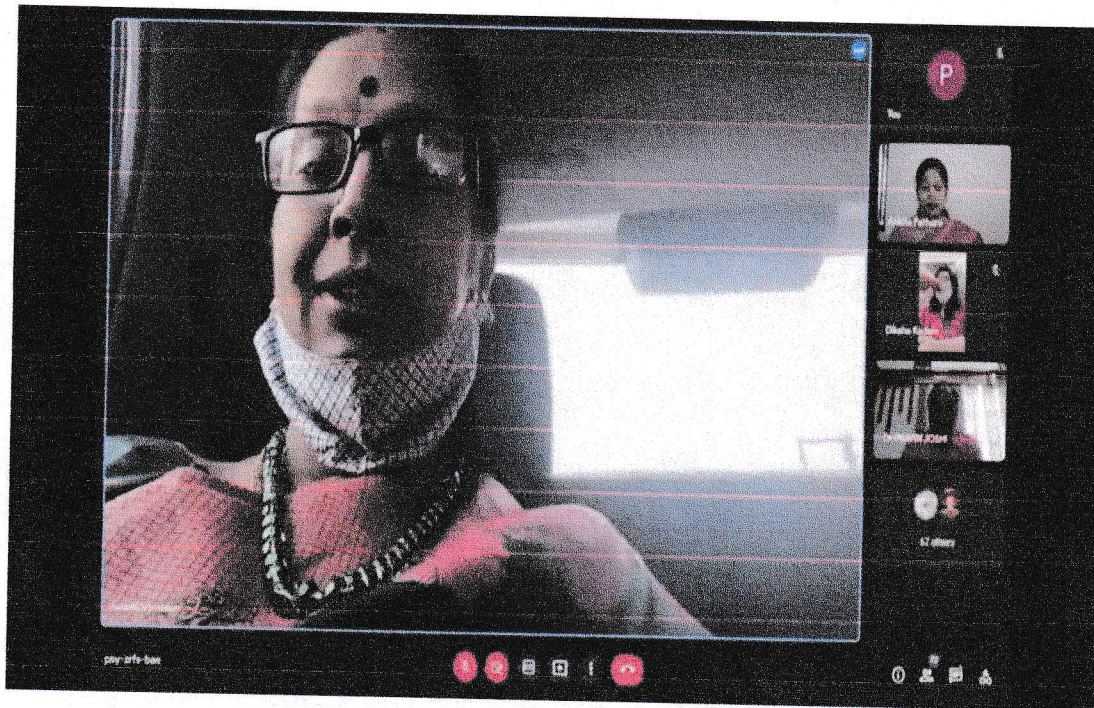

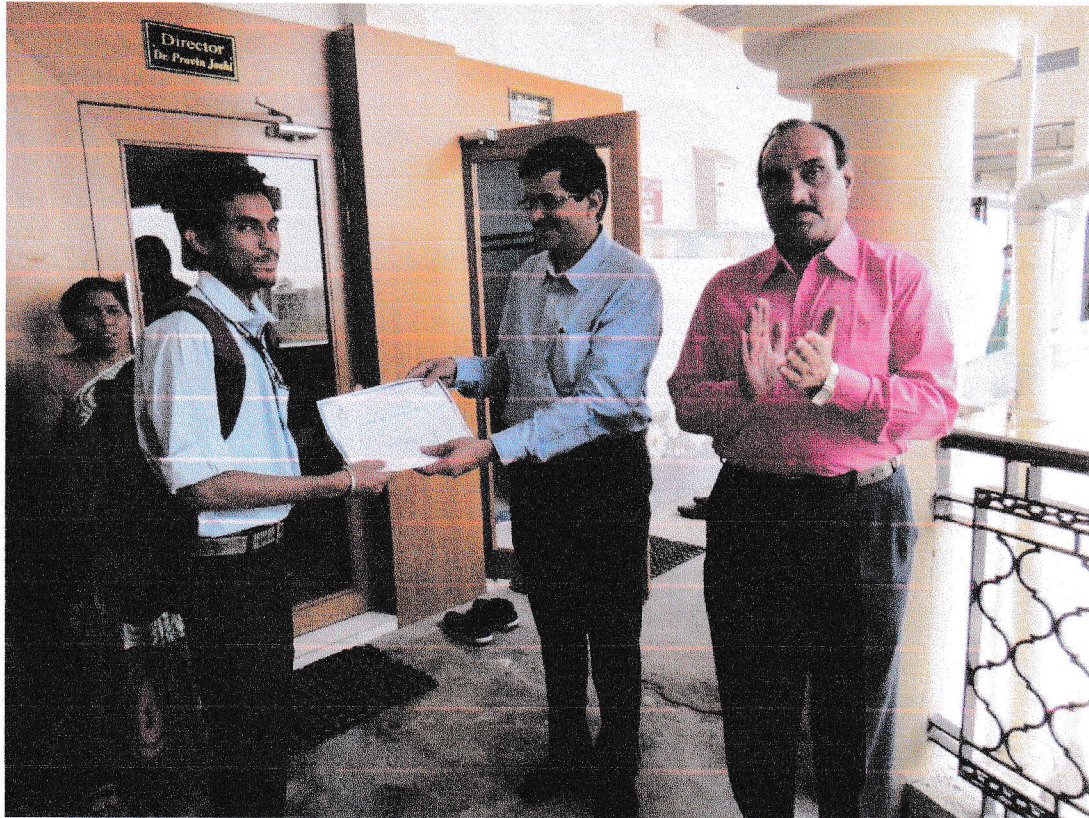
Snap of International Women's Day Rally
