Objectives:

1. To provide Students a set of basic rules that allow for minimal coordination amongst members of society.
2. To inform Students who has the power to make decisions in a society. It decides how the government will be constituted.
3. To make Students understand set some limits on what a government can impose on its citizens. These limits are fundamental in the sense that government may never trespass on them.
4. To make Students aware that the government has to fulfil the aspirations of a society and create conditions for a just society.

Highlights:

1. To make students aware about their fundamental duties legal aid camp was organized on 28th November 2022.
2. The Constitution of India is important because it ensures that decision-makers on behalf of the people are a fair representation of public opinion. It laid down the ways in which officials exercising power could be held accountable to the people they served.



3. The chief guest of the program Mr. Anil Sharma and Adv. SoniyaGajbhiye and Adv ShilpaGiradkar announced an Essay competition on topic 'Importance of Constitution'.
4. Students submitted essays on 30th November 2022 in written format.
5. The essays submitted were in English language in about 700-1000 words.
6. The evaluation of the essays was done on the basic of Relevance to the theme, comprehensiveness, originality and insight to the topic.
7. Top 3 essays and one consolation were awarded by certificate, cash prize and a hand book by high court.
8. A copy of hand book of constitution was presented by the high court to the institution.

Outcomes:

1. Students learn about the form of government that we follow and about its roles in political community.
2. Students realized that constitution is a framework for socio-economic development.
3. Students got aware that every government should have a strong political structure.
4. Students analyzed that the constitution serves the purpose of selecting fair and incorrupt government.
