REPORT ON NSS SPECIAL CAMP (RESIDENTIAL) HELD AT VILLAGE – ADYALI, VIHIRGAON

NSS was established in 1969 with a vision of personality development of students through community service as well as development of rural areas in India. NSS Unit has been introduced in colleges with an objective of establishing a sense of social responsibility amongst students and inculcating values of self-discipline and selfless dedication towards community development.

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NSS unit of Prerna College of Commerce, Nagpur organized a special camp in the village Adyali from 18-01-2023 to 24-01-2023. This special camp was organized with the help of Gram Panchayat Department of Vihirgaon. The Volunteers of the NSS unit performed many other activities – Cleanliness drive, awareness programmes as literacy, health and hygiene, construction and repairs, communal harmony, etc.

PRE-PREPARATIONS

The Coordinators of NSS camp gathered all the volunteers for an Orientation session from 11:00 A.M. – 12:00 noon. In the session, the coordinators explained the volunteers about the importance of NSS camp, role of volunteers, schedule of the camp and the tasks that the volunteers have to carry out. They also informed the volunteers about the rules and duties to be



followed in the camp, dress code, and other essentials required for the camp. Teachers share their experience with the current volunteers and informed them how to behave in the camp. Also, the volunteers were divided into groups for different task forces in the camp and also student coordinators were selected for the respective task forces. The faculty coordinators of the camp gave consent forms which are to be signed by the parents of the volunteers. In the end, faculty coordinators asked the volunteers to assemble by 1:00 pm on 18/01/2023 to leave from college to the camp. Finally, the session got ended with excitement and enthusiasm of the volunteers to be part of the NSS Special Camp.

NSS Unit of Prerna College of Commerce organised various activities for the whole year/session of 2022-2023, still a need was felt to organise a NSS Winter Special Camp for NSS Volunteers of the college. Accordingly a proposal was submitted by Dr. Sopandeo Pise, NSS Programme Officer in a meeting with NSS Unit and all programme officers in Nagpur City. A comprehensive action plan was designed to invite resource persons from various Departments such as Administrative, Horticulture, Health, Agriculture, etc.

2. INTRODUCTION

Camps provide a sound environment for youth to be active, to develop competence in life skills, to learn about and enhance their abilities to serve community.

OBJECTIVES OF EVENT:

- (i) Making education more relevant to the present situation to meet the felt needs of the communities and supplement the education of college students by bringing them face to face with the community situation.

- (iv) Building up potential youth leaders by exploring the latent potential among the campers, both students as well as local youth (rural and urban), with a view to involve them more intimately in development projects for longer periods.



- (v) Encouraging youth to participate enthusiastically in the process of national development, and promote national integration through democratic living and cooperative action.
- (vi) The foremost objective of the camp was surely towards community service and to inculcate social values in the youth in general and NSS Volunteers in particular so that a healthy society could be created.

Day – 1:

Wednesday 18th January 2023

The session of the Day began with a Procession by volunteers in the village. Volunteers rallied into the streets of the village to create awareness among the villagers about the ensuing special camp programme in their village for a period of one week. This was followed by an inauguration Program. The programme was started with pouring water to tree a symbol of conserving nature and NSS song.

The chief guest of ceremony Dr S.C. Gulhane, Secretary Prerna Sewa Mandal, Ms. Abhilasha Gudadhe CEO, Prerna Sewa Mandal, Dr Pravin Joshi, Director Prerna College of Commerce and Principal Dr Prakash Durugkar Prerna College of Commerce and 10 villagers with NSS program officer Dr Manjiri Pathak and other Teaching Staff Members Dr Ashish Gupta, Ms. Poorwa Wagh, Ms. Deepawali Randive And Mr Gaurav Gajbe along with NSS Volunteers. The inaugural speech was delivered by dignitaries, emphasised the role of NSS in the community service. Importance of cleanliness & use of water. Sarpanch of the Village and several village people attended the function. During the evening of the First Day Volunteers interacted with Village people and visited the people in their houses discussed about their needs and requirements and harms in the village. Volunteers created awareness through door to door campaign on cleanliness, spread of diseases, importance of environment, cleanliness and agriculture. After taking dinner volunteers discussed the camp agenda and activities with NSS programme officer, also volunteers form the various groups and discussed the role of each role before going into the bed volunteers sang the NSS song.

Day – 3
