### **Highlights: -**

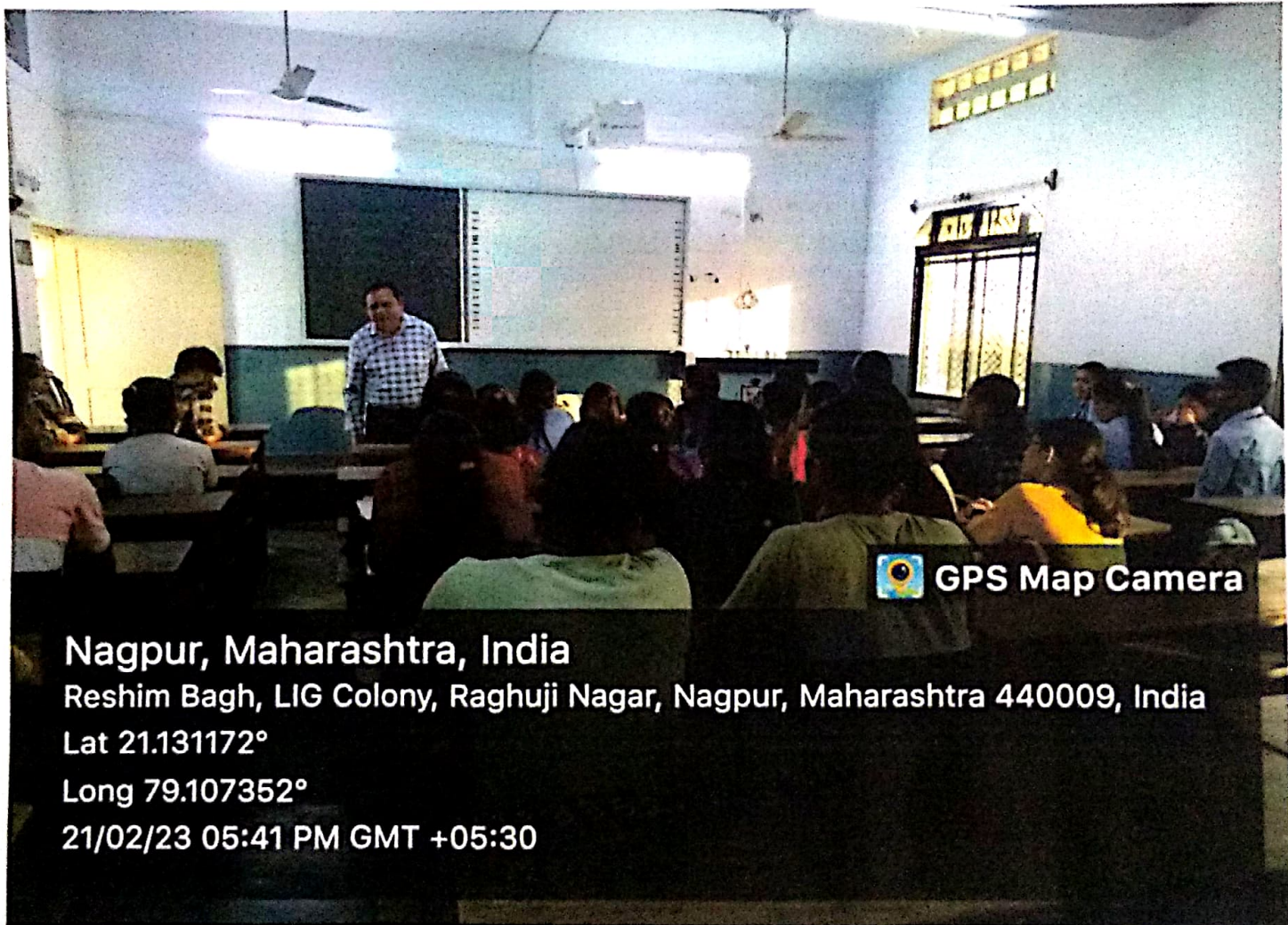
