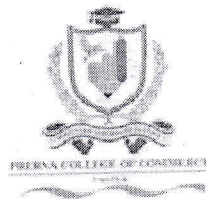

3. Students Understand "diversity" beyond race/culture


