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Outcomes: -

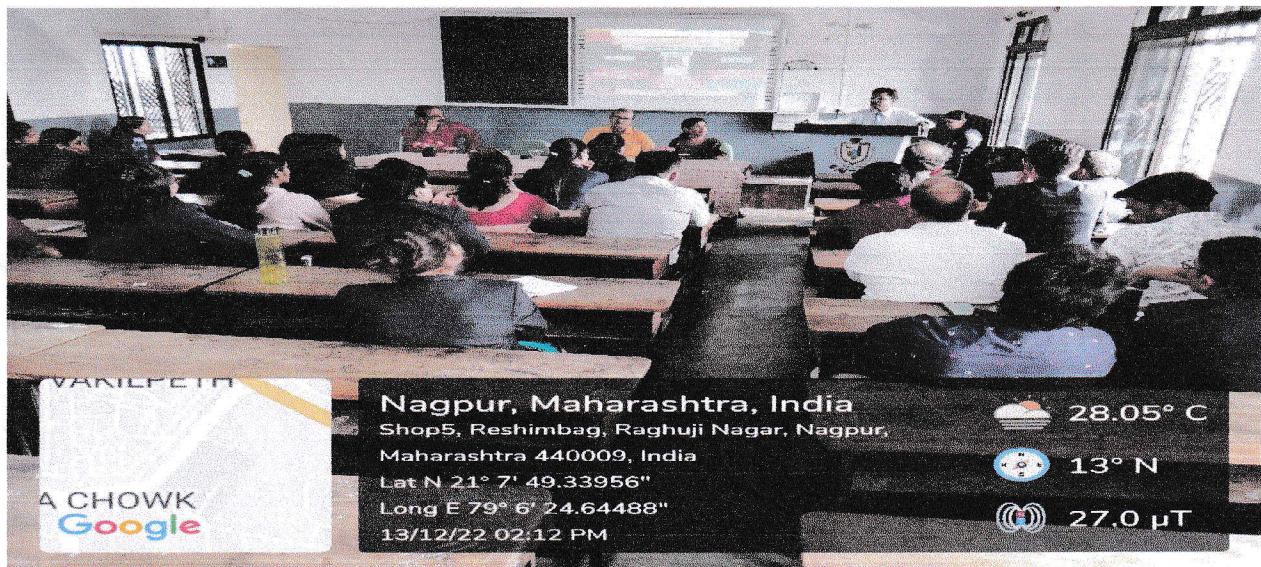
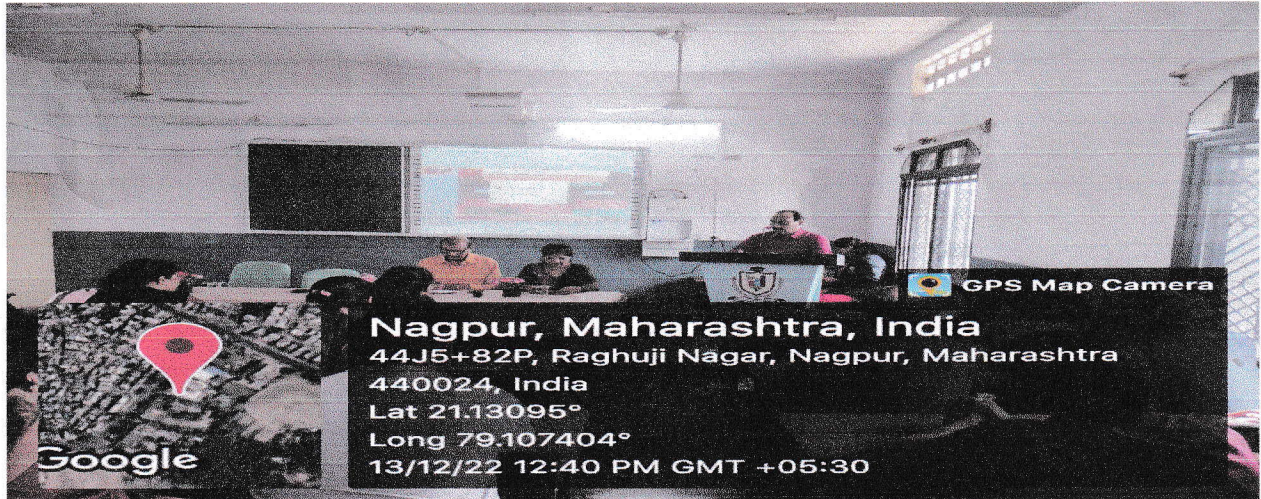
1. The teachers learned how to prepare students for accepting the challenges of life.
