- They are aware of the importance of self-control, motivation, and focus in daily life.

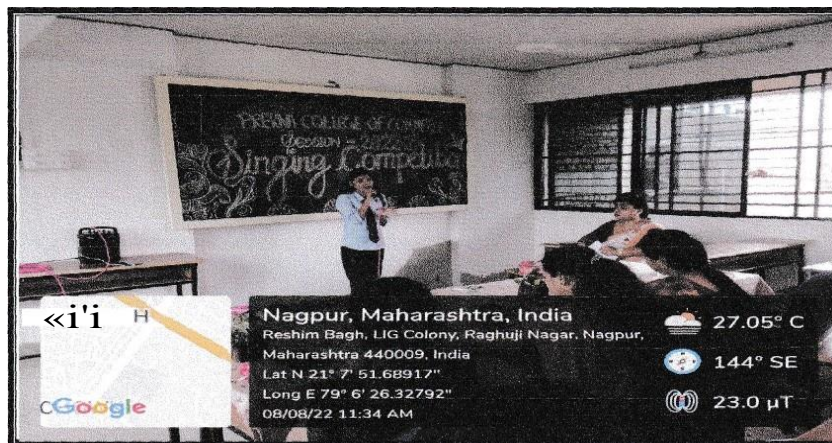

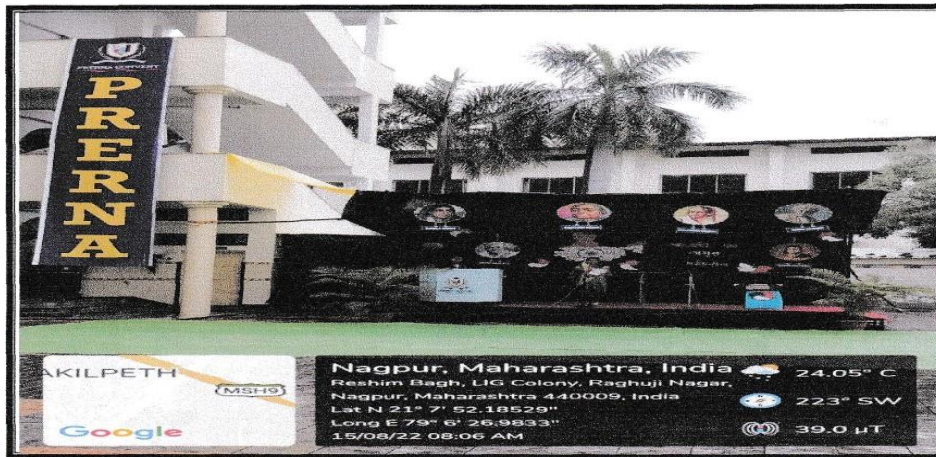

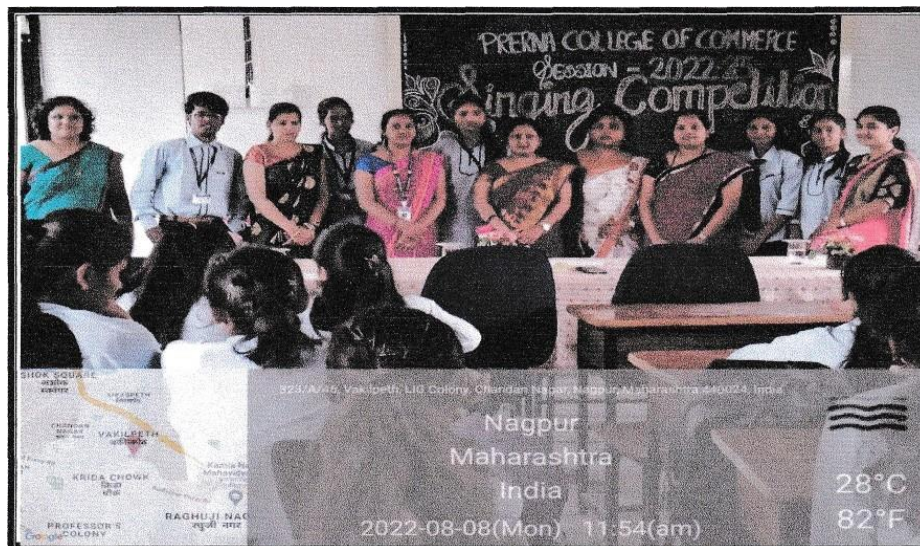
