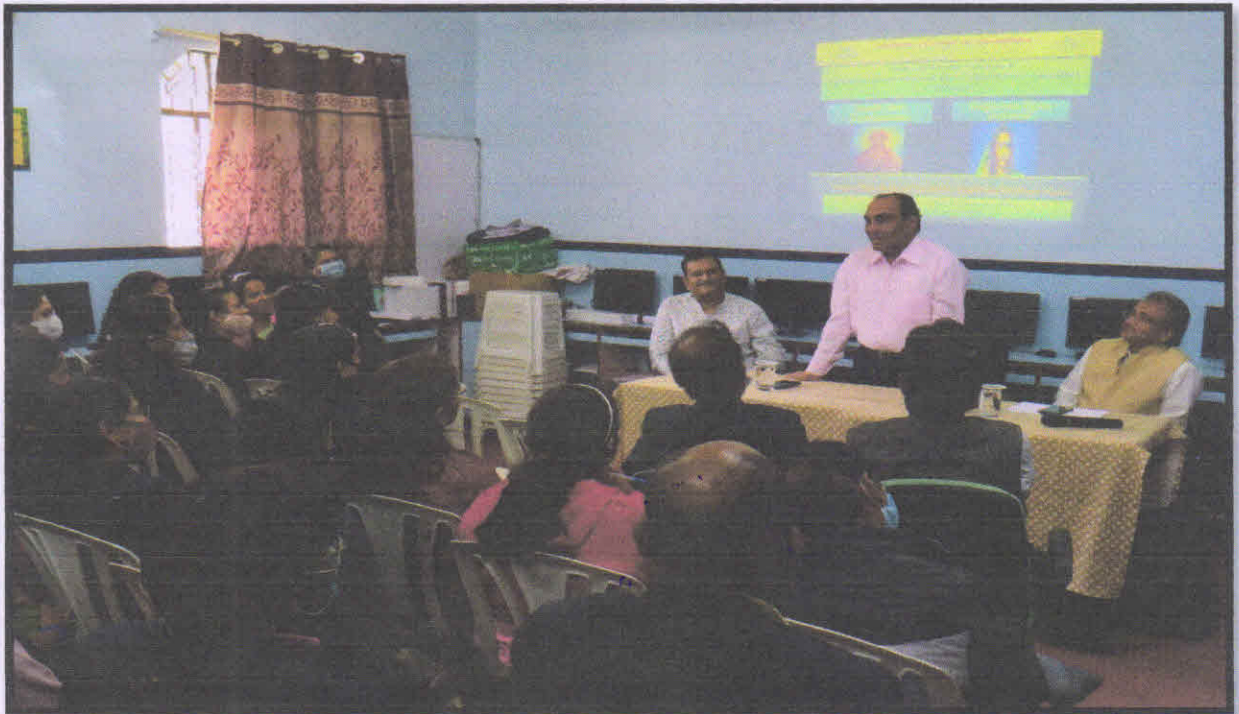
1. Ms. Afsha Khan Compared the program.

6. Dr. Rewatkar was also present on the dice.

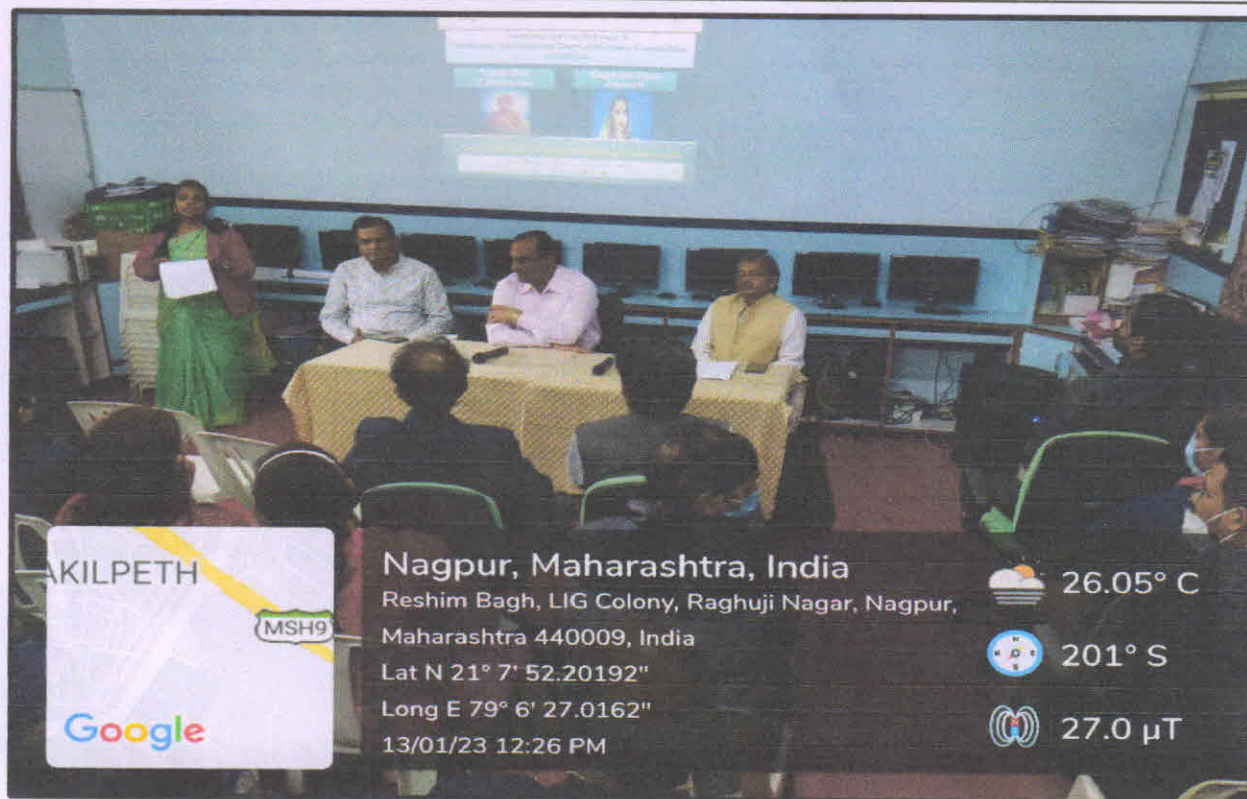
Outcome: -
