6. To teach effective job search strategies, including how to search for job openings, submit applications, and utilize online job portals and professional networks.

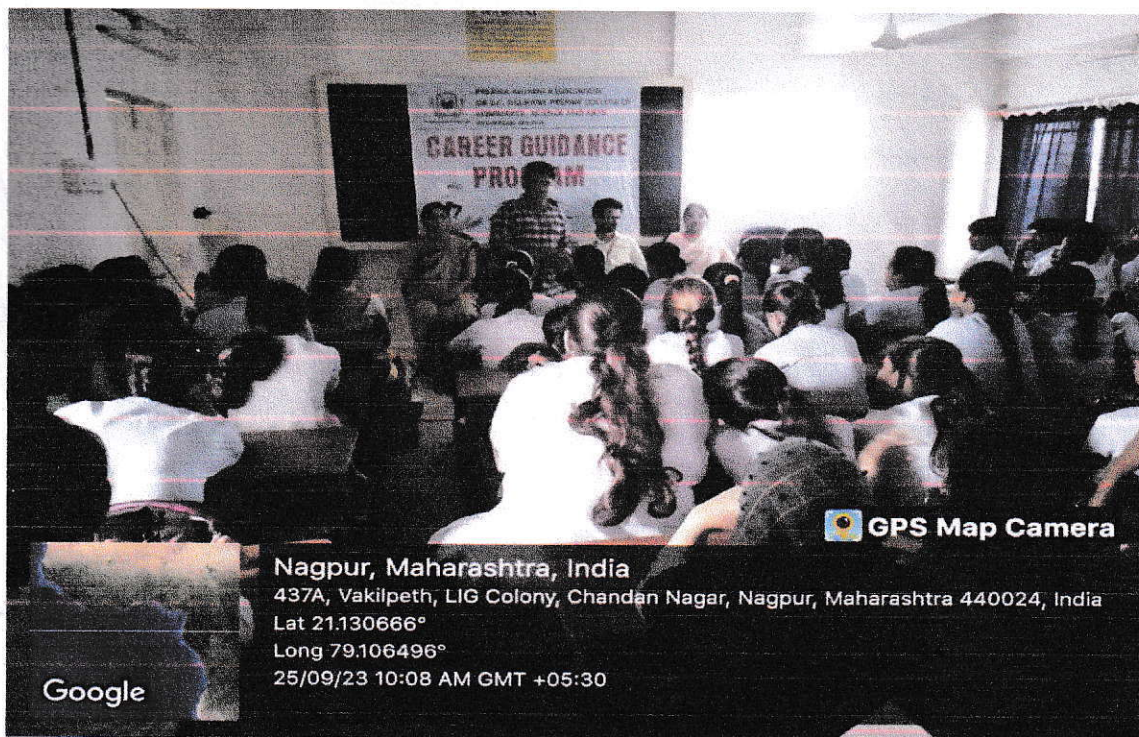
Events Highlights:

5. The program concluded with a vote of thanks extended by Ms. Seema Kohad, expressing gratitude to all attendees.

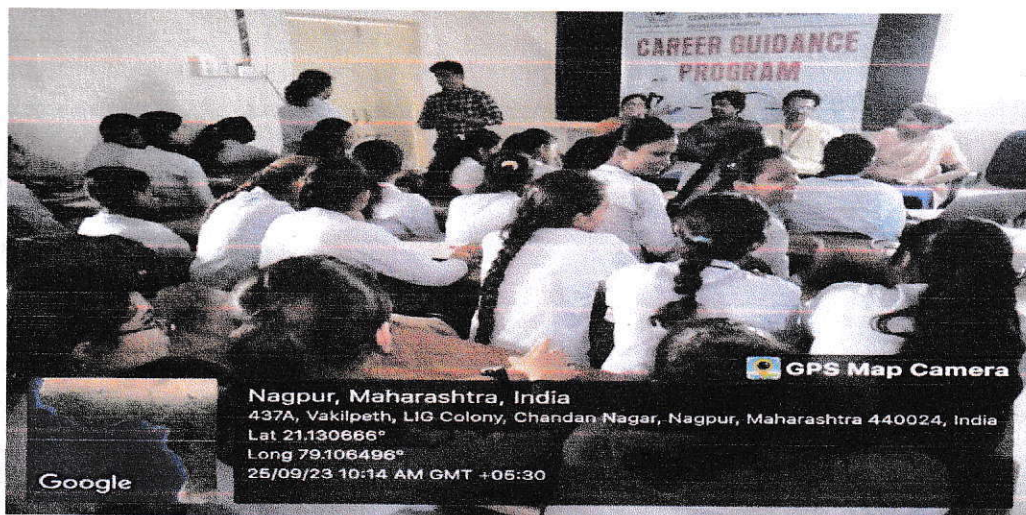
Program Outcomes:
