8. The program was compered by Ms Priya Godbole and Ms Swarda Gulhane proposed a vote of thanks.

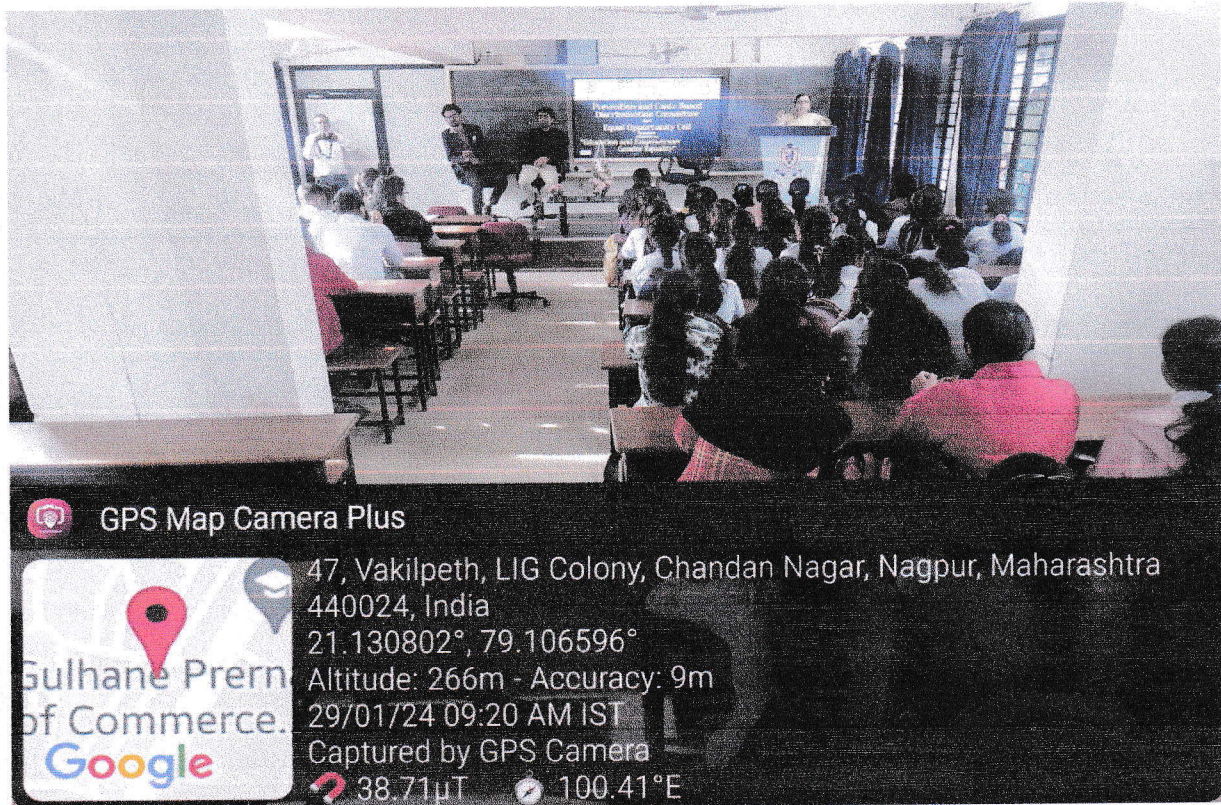
Outcomes:

7. This program helped the students to know importance of education and empowerment.

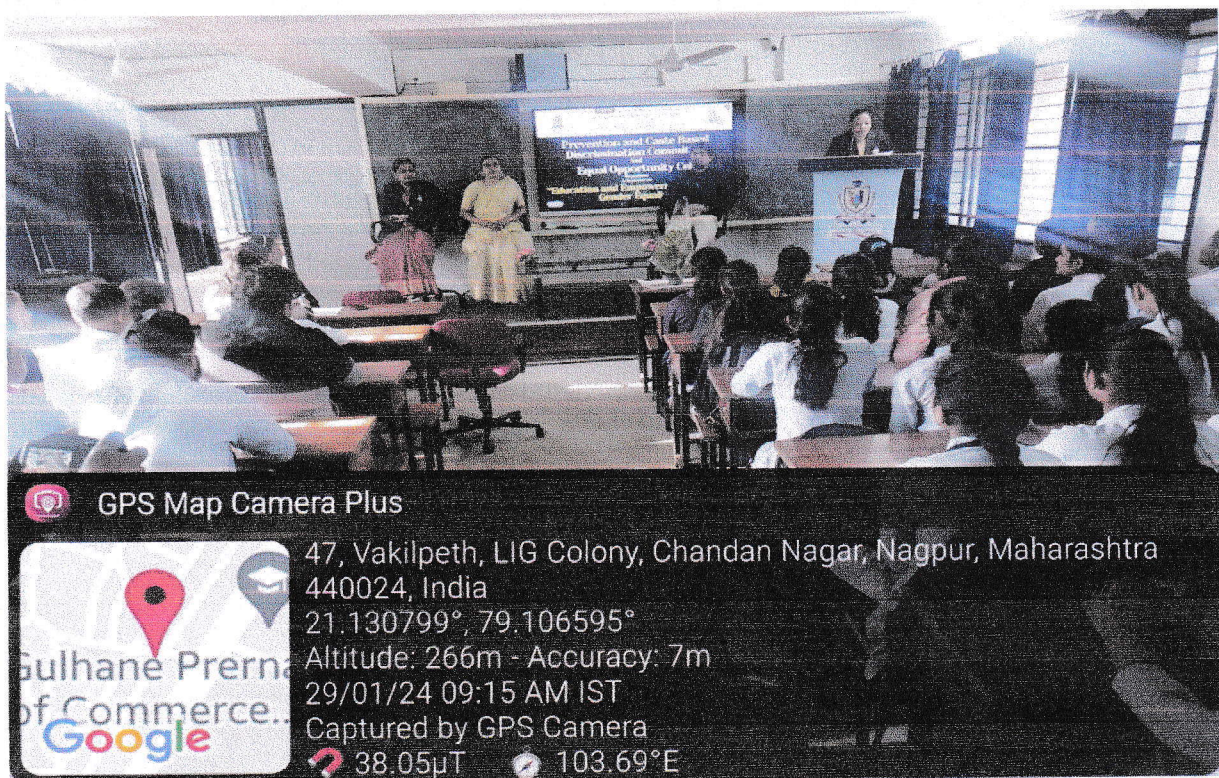
Number of Beneficiaries:
