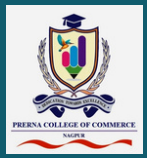

CONCEPT NOTE:



New Education Policy 2020 is a national level document which aims at the overall positive transformation in the nationwide education policy. This new policy on education has come almost after 35 years to bring the overall education in India at par with the global standards. It lays down the framework for the transformational reforms not only at school level but also in higher education in india .

This policy inspires 100% gross enrolment ratio in school education in next 10 years with a view to providing education to everybody in the country. At the same time in the field of higher education it plans to raise the ratio from 27% to almost 60%. It also aims at achieving the universalization of education from pre-school to secondary level. It also envisages imparting global level quality education for all in different streams of education. It is believed that the policy of introducing multi- disciplinary institutes will lead to a renewed focus on every field of knowledge and studies for the holistic development of students.

However, many thinkers and educationists have raised serious doubts about the attainment of the goals that the New Education Policy has set before it. Those who are skeptics about the total success of the NEP keep on saying that there are serious lags in both, the thinking and the document.

They have also raised doubts about the universal acceptance of the imparting of education in mother tongue at primary level. The aspect of multi linguisticism is also highly criticized as some states are against the imposition of Hindi on them.

The availability of funds for the implementation of policy is doubted at all levels right from the ministries concerned to the common man. Many consider the New Education Policy as over ambitious and they say that without considering its pros and cons it is being implemented in haste. In such way the NEP possesses certain challenges before it is fully implemented.

This conference aims at giving critical thought to the attainable's and the unattainable's incorporated in the NEP. It aims to look into the opportunities and the challenges that the NEP is going to put before the nation.

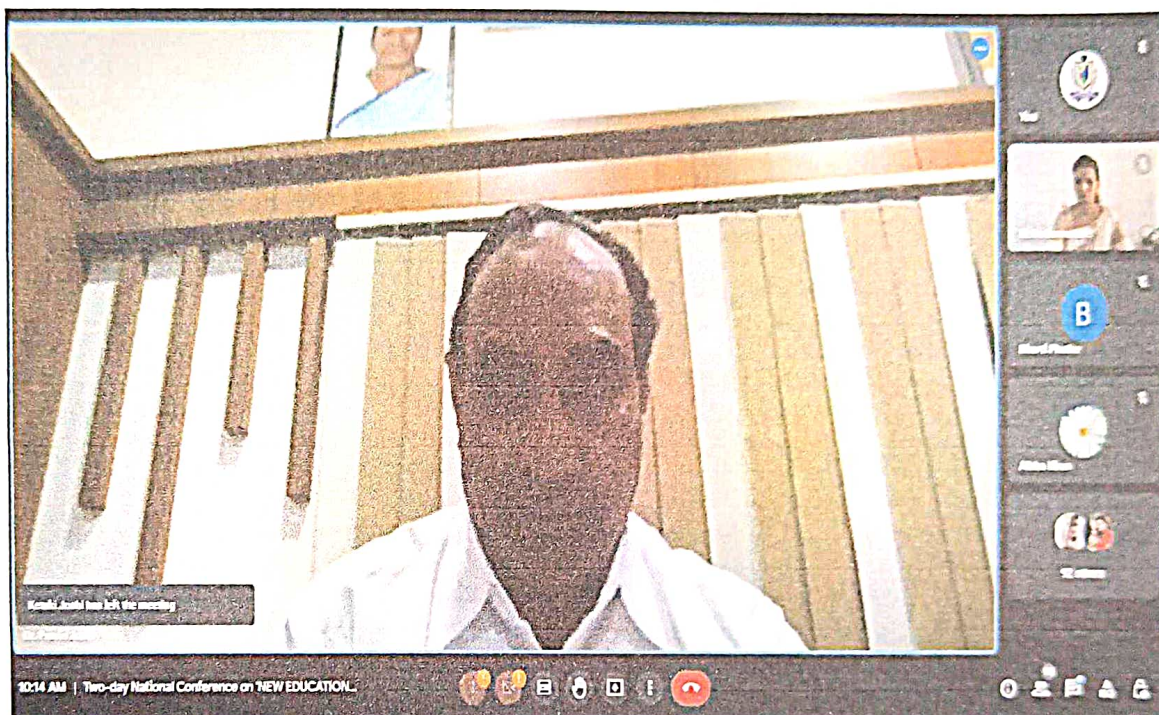
Outcomes: -

4. The faculty members learnt and developed a positive attitude towards New Education Policy.

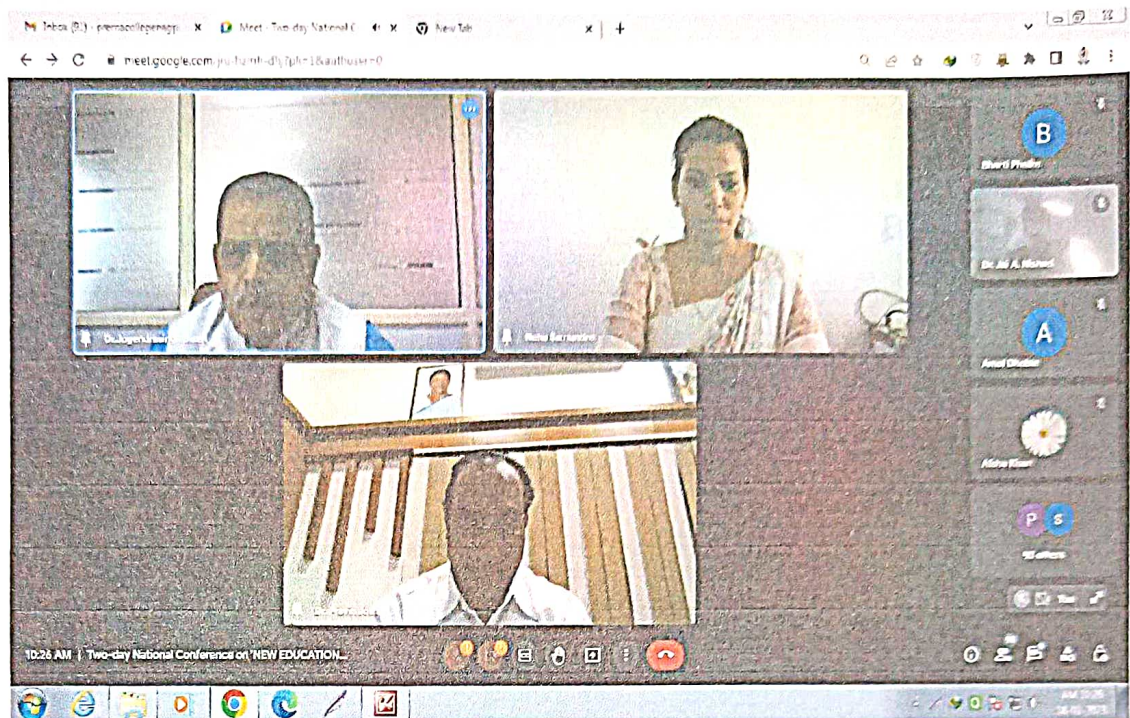
5. The teachers acquired essential knowledge about New Education Policy and its use with advance technology.
