Objectives: -

1. To learn and understand all the aspects of fundamental duties and responsibilities.
2. To understand and analyze the main components of the Indian constitution that are related to the adherence of duties and responsibilities.
3. To grasp the fundamental duties and their importance in protecting our fundamental rights.
4. To analyze the relationship between Fundamental Duties and fundamental rights.
5. To imbibe democratic conduct and democratic behavior among the students.
6. To enlighten the students with the importance of the execution of fundamental duties and responsibilities

Highlights: -

1. Ms Sakshi Shivhare compered the session and elaborated on the need of having a session on explaining the Duties and responsibilities of Citizens.
2. Dr Pravin Joshi provided the introductory remarks and threw light on how conscious we should be while operating in the society we are residing in.
3. Dr Amar Singh started the session with an explanation of why these duties and responsibilities were given in the first place.
4. He elaborated on the problem of discrimination and exactly how we can deal with

it using our Fundamental duties.

5. He favored the holistic approach behind the formulation of fundamental duties which is aimed at empowering each and every citizen.
6. Sir enlightened the students on how to handle power without doing any kind of corruption.
7. Dr Amar Singh exclaimed that fundamental rights denote what others should do for us but fundamental duties entail what we should do for others.
8. Sir made the students understand the purpose of fundamental duties.
9. He said the main purpose of fundamental rights is to preserve individual liberty.
10. Sir stated that the fundamental duties are aimed at preserving your and other people's rights.
11. Sir explained how important it is to understand the fundamental duties first because without understanding the duties one cannot imagine its execution.
12. Dr Amar Singh elaborated all the fundamental duties with their very crux. Sir also explained the practical application of all the duties and how we can make its execution a part of our daily routine.
13. Sir concluded the session with an inspirational message to the students and encouraged the students to execute their Fundamental duties with a sense of responsibility.
14. Ms Roshni Mahajan proposed the Vote of Thanks and took the session to its closure.

Outcome: -

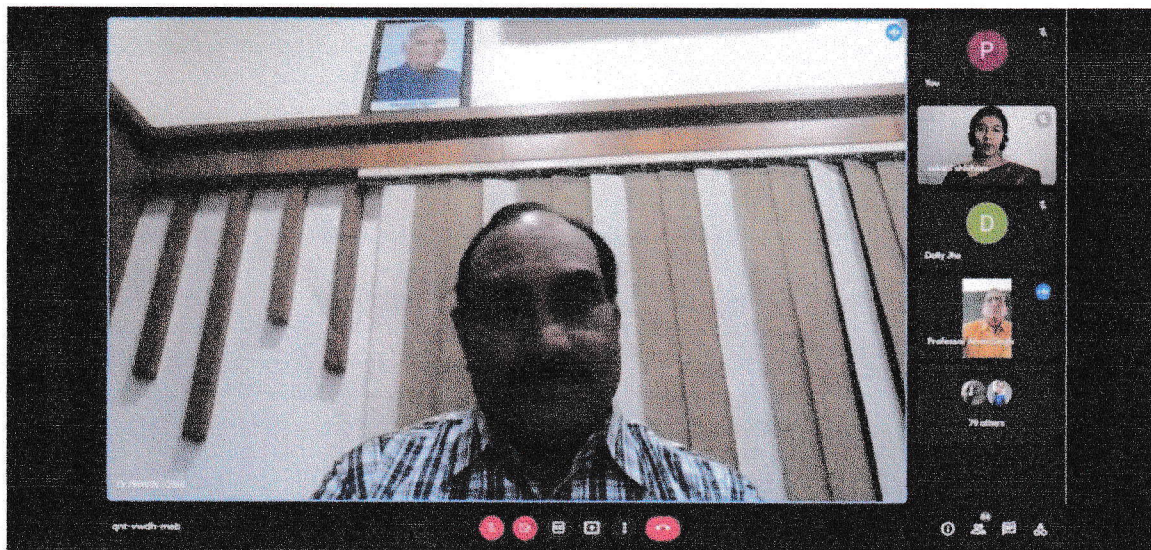
1. Students got to understand the fundamental duties and responsibilities in the simplest way possible.

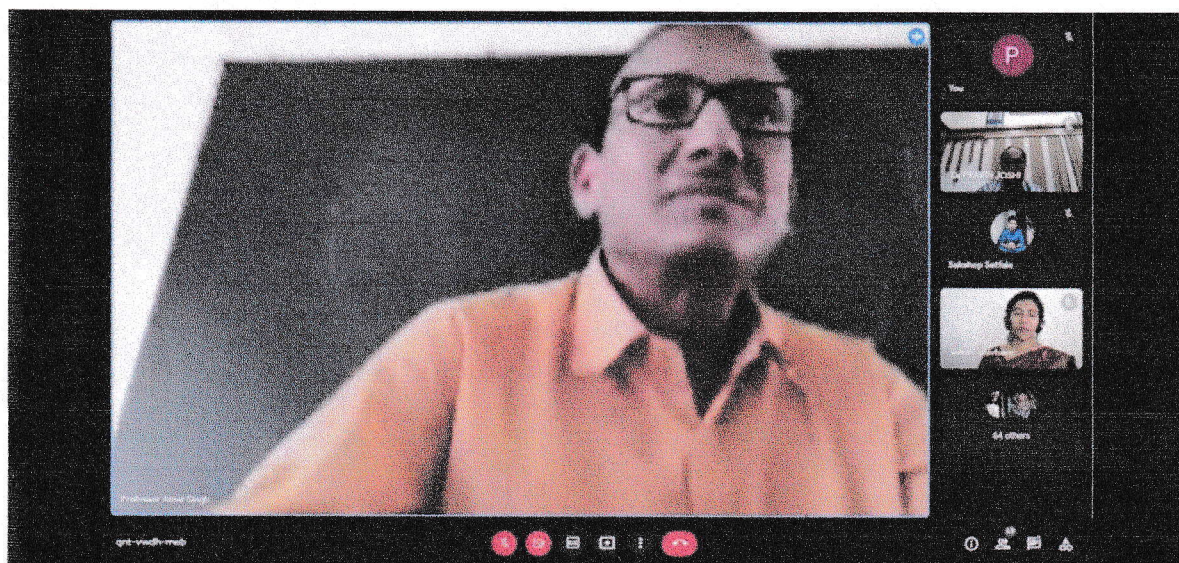
