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

A) Students should have Passed the 12th Standard Examination of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education/CBSE/ICSE, with English at Higher or Lower level and any Modern Indian Language at higher or lower level with any combination of optional subjects.

OR

B) XII Standard Examination of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education in Vocational Stream with one language only.

OR

any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto; in such subjects and with such standards of attainments as may be prescribed Minimum Competition vocation course (MCVC).

OR

C) Any other Equivalent Examination of any State in (10+2) pattern with any combination of subjects.

B.Sc. (Finance)-I
