


REPORT – DAY 1




Presently, he is freelancing as an HR Trainer, Motivator, and Educator.

DAY 3 – REPORT




His poems and research articles have been published in many literary and indexed journals. He has also worked with the British Council for 3 years for syllabus and material development.




DAY – 5 REPORT

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

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
DAY 9 – REPORT


