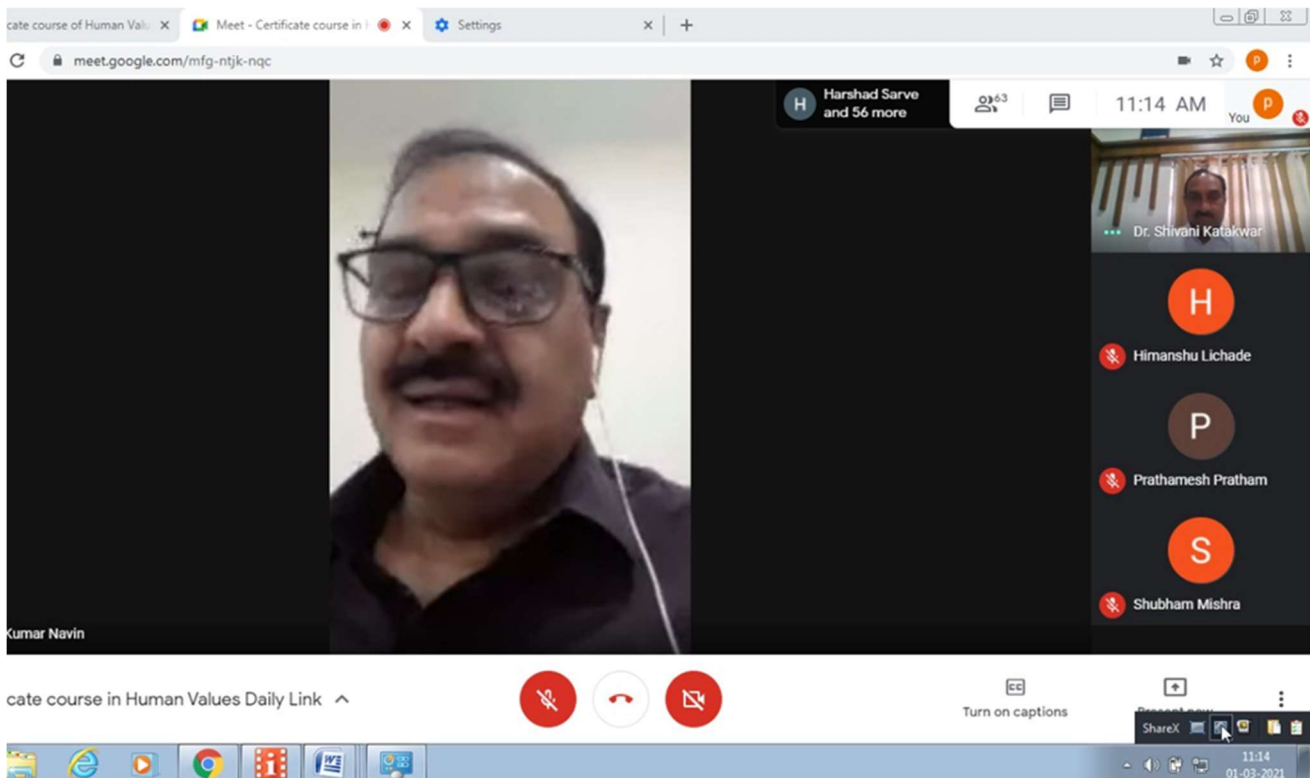
Outcome:

6. They have also learned why the observance of manners is necessary in our life.

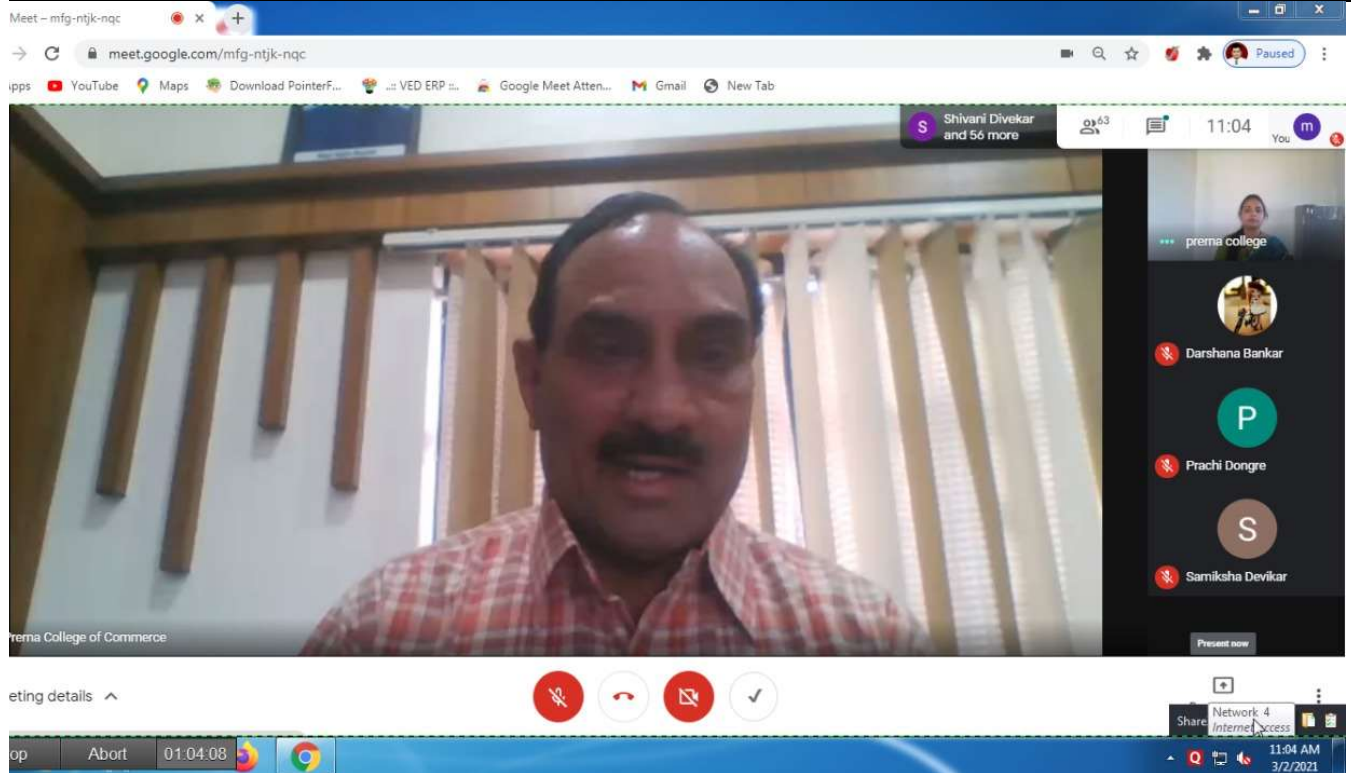
7. They also learned how to undertake the journey of a life from human being to being human.

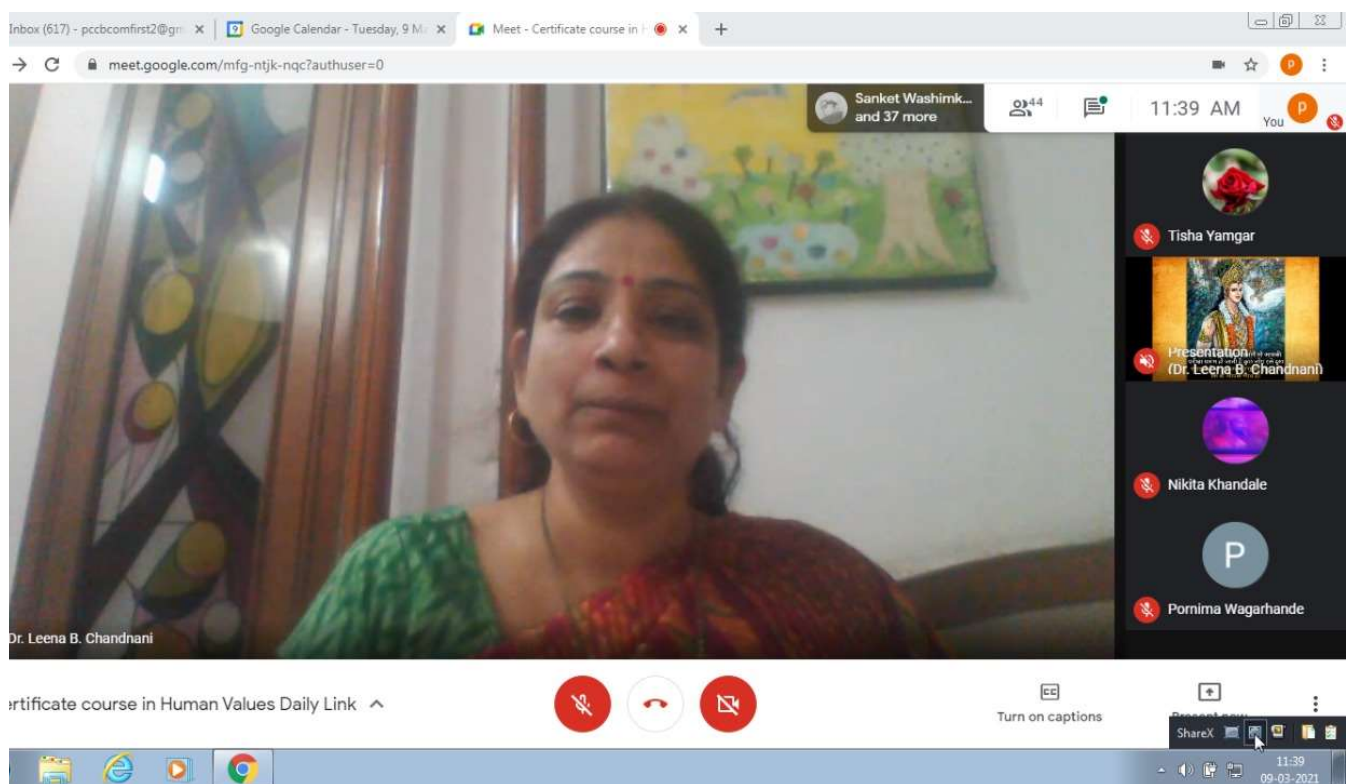
