6. Build communication and research skills useful for academic careers, publishing, media, writing, teaching, editing, or further higher studies (like PhD).
7. Develop a social/cultural awareness through literature - ability to reflect on social, historical, political issues via literary study; empathy, critical thinking, ethical sensibility, and broader worldview.
